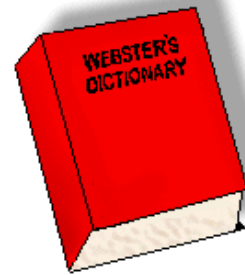


WHAT IS TRANSLATION AND WHY IS IT IMPORTANT

What does REAL translation look like?

What REAL translation IS NOT!

- A QUICK and EASY process, with only ONE outcome.
- Putting ISOLATED Latin sentences into English.
- KNOWING the definition of EVERY word in a sentence. You only need a dictionary to know that information!

What REAL translation IS!

- An ART, one that requires TRAINING, great EFFORT, and TIME to achieve.
- Transferring a CONTINUOUS narrative from one language into another the best way you can. There CAN BE more than one CORRECT translation!
- KNOWING as MANY WORDS as possible. When you see a word that you do not know, AND THIS WILL HAPPEN, DO NOT STOP TRYING. REMAIN METNALLY STRONG. At this stage of your Latin journey, this reality is why it is so very important for you to study EXACTLY what passages I tell you to study.
