• Research shows that RULER reduces problem behavior, promotes positive relationships, and improves academic achievement.

- R ecognizing emotions in oneself and others
- U nderstanding the causes and consequences of emotions
- abeling emotions with a nuanced vocabulary
- Expressing emotions in accordance with cultural norms and social context
- R egulating emotions with helpful strategies






