A few reminders ...

from the WMS Student Handbook:

The eighth grade dinner dance is held in June for eighth grade students only. **No** guests may attend. A catered dinner is served, and dancing will follow. This affair is formal.

Boys are expected to wear sport jackets and ties, and girls are expected to wear “party” dresses, skirts or dress slacks. Tuxedos, prom gowns and limousines are prohibited. All attire is expected to be appropriate for a middle school dance. Students are encouraged to dress in a manner that reflects pride in and respect for themselves, others, their school, and their community. If there is a concern about a student’s apparel at this dance, parents will be notified and students will be asked to leave.

Students must be in school and remain in attendance until at least 12:00 p.m. the day of the dance.

In order for your child to leave early that day, the following **MUST** be done:

- A note **MUST** be handed in to the office by Wednesday 6/8.
- The note must specify the time of pickup and the person picking up your child.

Please note the following:

- If the note says that the pick-up time is 12:15, the student will **NOT** be called down to the office until that time.
- If a note is not received by the end of the day on **6/8**, your child will not be allowed to leave early.
