

# 3-DAY INTRODUCTORY COURSE

## Foundational Program of All Reading Programs Offered by Wilson Language Training

WRS is based on Orton-Gillingham principles and is a highly-structured, intensive, Tier 3 reading program for students in grades 2-12 with word-level difficulties or language-based learning disabilities. WRS offers direct instruction on the structure of language to students who have been unable to learn through other teaching strategies or who may require multisensory language instruction.

## Upon Completion of the Course

- Define dyslexia and describe common characteristics.
- Explain the process of identifying appropriate students and placing them in WRS.
- Understand the principles of instruction: explicit, sequential and cumulative, engaging multiple learning modalities with multisensory techniques, repetition, and feedback.
- Create an optimal learning environment, prepare a lesson plan, and practice techniques.
- Understand the key components of instruction and presentation of lessons in three blocks: Word-Study/Foundational Reading Skills, Spelling/Foundational Writing Skills, and Fluency/Comprehension.
