### **Structure**

- ❖REP COUNCIL Consists of building based, local union representatives elected by building teachers.
- Building Reps are your first line of assistance when issues arise.
- See your Building Rep for union related questions and if you are called into a meeting with school officials that you believe may result in discipline.

### **Structure**

- Building Reps conduct regular building based union meetings, called TEN MINUTE MEETINGS.
- These meetings are scheduled either before or after school and connect you with district wide issues that the WTA is addressing for teachers.
- All teachers are encouraged to attend the ten minute meetings for union based information and policy changes.





#### A. Employment & Human Resource Services

- 1. WTA President, Officers and Building Reps, along with full time CEA Representative (Attorney) provide help with employment related issues for all Waterbury teachers.
- 2. Six Member Grievance Committee to assist with grievance handling/processing.
  - 3. Representation with disciplinary and workplace related issues and concerns.
- 4. Full counsel services and representation through grievance process and potential arbitration.










## A Few Things To Remember...


