

Xerox Managed Print Program Initiative for Wallingford Public Schools

The objective of the Xerox Managed Print Program for Wallingford Public Schools is to provide management capability and reporting for all devices that put ink on paper. In the past, only copiers were tracked for volume, user responsibility, and supplies. However, now with the implementation of the Xerox Print Management Program, Wallingford Public Schools now has the ability to monitor and receive reports on volume, user responsibility, and supplies for the MFD's and networked laser printers in the school district. We are also able to monitor all the MFD's and networked laser printers proactively for service and supplies.

The Xerox Managed Print Program also has a major financial cost benefit associated with it for the district. For instance, every print that is migrated from a laser printer to a MFD, the school district saves additional \$ per print. You are encouraged to migrate as much print to the MFD's as possible. Using 2 sided copying/printing whenever possible is also recommended.

The following are the relative costs for printing:

Xerox MFD / Copier excess print rate:

b&w print .0037

color print .0477

HP / other Laser printers excess print rate:

b&w print .011

color print .10
