8th Grade Math

This week students will be working on standards MGSE8.F.1, MGSE8.F.2, MGSE8.F.3, MGSE8.F.4, and MGSE8.F.5. Students will find the slope given a line, interpret the slope given a real life situation, and graph linear equations using the slope and y-intercept. If time permits, students will begin writing equations of lines given the slope and a point, the slope and a point, two points, and a graph.

Accelerated Algebra I

This week students will be working on standards MGSE9-12.F.BF.2 and MGSE9-12.F.BF.3 Students will find the next three terms in a geometric sequence or the nth term of a geometric sequence. They will

learn about exponential growth, decay, compound interest, and half-life. If time permits, students will begin graphing exponential equations.

Georgia Studies

Georgia Studies students will continue the unit on Georgia's Government.
