Standards include:

Social Studies:

We will wrap up our unit on the Great Depression and New Deal with a test on Wednesday. Your child has notes they can study and there is a powerpoint in Google Classroom they can use as well. We will begin making vocabulary notecards for our WW2 unit.

Math:

Standards include: **MGSE5.NBT.7** Add, subtract, **multiply, and divide** decimals to hundredths, using concrete models or drawings and strategies based on place value, properties of operations, and/or the relationship between addition and subtraction; relate the strategy to a written method and explain the reasoning used.

We are concluding Unit 3 with a review of multiplying and dividing decimals. Our **Unit 3 Assessment will be Friday Nov. 22.** Study guides can be found on my website as well as in Google Classroom.

Accelerated Math:

Standards include: **MGSE6.G.4** Represent three-dimensional figures using nets made up of rectangles and triangles, and use the nets to find the surface area of these figures. Apply these techniques in the context of solving real -world and mathematical problems.

We will continue our 3rd Unit: Geometry this week using nets to find surface area. **Unit 2 – Retest will be Friday Nov. 22.**

Science:

Standards Include:

S5L2. Obtain, evaluate, and communicate information showing that some characteristics of organisms are inherited and other characteristics are acquired.

We are working on our last Life Science Standard: Heredity. We will learn the difference between an inherited trait and a learned behavior.
