If a student chooses to go off campus, the off-campus placeholder must be at the **beginning or the end of the day** **AND** the student must have **daily transportation**. Students must leave campus. Students cannot stay on campus at all during an off-campus placeholder. Please note that, depending on availability, students may not be able to have more than one period in the on-campus eSchool lab. **Students can have a maximum of 3 eSchool placeholders.**
- Students who choose to take Dual Enrollment courses must meet the requirements listed below and have daily transportation if taking the class off-campus or online. Students must leave campus. Students cannot stay on campus at all during an off-campus placeholder.
