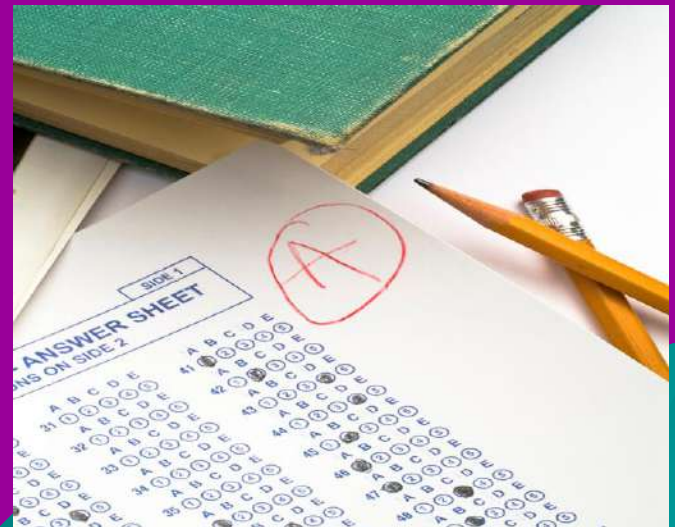
Types of Classes

- ◆ Elective - careers, art, drama, etc.
- ◆ Honors – more rigorous
- ◆ Advanced Placement (AP) - college credit potential
- ◆ Career pathway

 - ◆ It **typically** gets changed.
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
Registering for Electives

- ◆ Portal opens Feb. 18 and closes Mar. 6 to register for electives.
 - ◆ Make sure parents have a portal password or use yours from school.
 - ◆ The school will put in your core classes. You just select your electives.
 - ◆ Be **SURE** you select several alternates.
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Driver's Ed.

- ◆ Must pick as an elective.
- ◆ It is only a semester course, so you must select another semester course to go with it: World Geography, etc.
