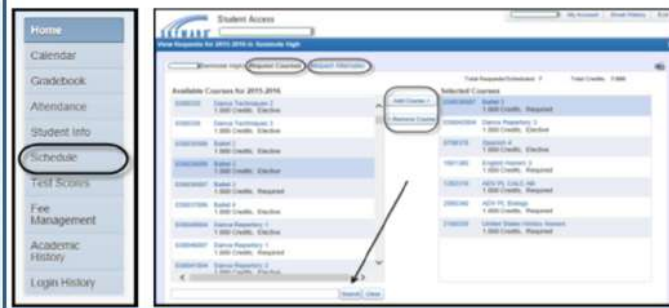

- 1. Click on Schedule.
- 2. Click on the **REQUEST COURSES** tab
- 3. Scroll to find your course and highlight it or input the course number, click **ADD COURSE**, repeat steps for each course.
- 4. Be sure your **CREDITS** total 7.0.
- 5. Click on Request Alternates tab and register for 4 alternate courses.
