Remember that a song does not explicitly teach the concept, but it can serve as a way for your kids to make connections and deepen understanding.

Math Bingo	Media Center	6:00-6:30 7:00- 8:00	Research has shown that long-term success in mathematics is closely tied to strong number sense, including fluency with basic facts. In order for students to become fluent with their basic facts, they need to develop strategies that move beyond counting. Using Flash Cards and Number Talks are great strategies to support math fact fluency.
