Components of the Collegiate High School

- Students can earn an A.A. degree while still enrolled in high school.
- Students in grades 10 -11 will take a defined list of college courses at their high school in combination with high school classes.
- ✓ 12th grade students will enroll full time on SJR State's St. Augustine campus.

Eligibility

- Students are selected by invitation only based on a minimum 3.0 high school GPA in one or more classes.
- ✓ Level 3 or higher on the 8th grade reading FSA, a level 3 or higher on the 8th grade math FSA or a level 3 or higher on the Algebra 1 EOC.
- ✓ If the number of eligible students who apply exceeds the number of seats allocated for the program, a lottery will be applied for final selection.

- Development of critical and higher-order thinking skills
- Exposure to college campus resources and environment
- Accelerated pathway to a college degree
