Uses:

Students identified in this system will provide the base list of students who will be used to calculate the metrics described above. All students will have additional validation added for full academic year (FAY).

Timelines:

- On July 20, 2015, documents will be available to provide guidance associated with application.
- On July 21, 2015, an online training session will be provided by Office of Accountability and Data Management.
- On July 22, 2015, rosters will be loaded into ASV.
- On August 4, 2015 all rosters must be submitted to DOE for verification/approval.
- By August 10, 2015 all rosters will be approved or returned to district/school for additional action.
- On August 14, 2015, ASV will close for all and rosters will be finalized.
