# DeSana Middle School 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Field Trip TELLUS Museum in Cartersville, GA Behavior Agreement

Dear 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Student and Parent:

Students traveling on the DeSana 6<sup>th</sup> Grade field trip to TELLUS Museum in Cartersville, Georgia are expected to display a high caliber of well-mannered behavior at all times. Because our 6<sup>th</sup> grade students are representing DeSana Middle School as a whole, and because we are asking DeSana faculty, staff and parent chaperones to be responsible for students, our behavioral expectations are set at a high standard. Thus, any 6<sup>th</sup> grade student who:

- Commits any two (2) discipline infractions that result in In-School Suspensions/Saturday School between January 30, 2017 and May 14, 2017, will not be allowed to attend the 6<sup>th</sup> Grade field trip on May 15, 2017 (on the 2<sup>nd</sup> ISS assignment/Saturday School the student becomes ineligible for the trip).
- Commits any discipline infraction that results in Out-of-School Suspension between January 30, 2017 and May 14, 2017 will not be allowed to attend the 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Field Trip.
- Commits any act that is deemed egregious by the administration will not be allowed to attend the 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Field Trip.

If a student has made payments toward the trip and then loses the privilege of traveling on this trip because of inappropriate behavior, no refunds can be made by DeSana Middle School or *TELLUS Museum* until all trip expenses have been met and a cancellation fee is applied.

All students are expected to adhere to the 2016-17 Forsyth County Schools Code of Conduct and all policies and procedures as stated in the DeSana Middle School 2016-17 Student/Parent Handbook. Any discipline issue that occurs on the trip will be handled by the administrator(s) chaperoning the trip.
