All students/parents will need to have access to the FCS Infinite Campus Parent Portal in order to complete the course selection process. When using the Infinite Campus Parent Portal to select these elective courses (additional information & directions will be posted on the Forsyth Central Registration Web Page on <u>February 9, 2017</u>), use the only the course numbers listed below to identify & select the courses you want. Do not use the course title.

Students/Parents should select the number of elective courses to equal seven (7) classes and three (3) alternates. If a course has two numbers that end in an S (S represents a Semester Course), then each class must be entered individually into the Parent Portal to select them. The two "s" courses selected will "count" as one (1) class in the student's schedule (e.g. 60325s Driver's Education & 60165s Intro Team Sports).

All reasonable efforts will be made to complete student schedules with their preferred first course selections. If a student's first course selections are not available, then the student's schedule will be completed using alternate course selections if at all possible.
