Clayton County Public School Goals

By May 2018 all schools in CCPS will increase by 3% or more as measured by the College and Career Readiness Performance Index (CCRPI).

We will get there by increasing student skills in:

- Addition and Subtraction within 20
- Understanding Place Value
- Grouping in Tens and Ones
- Reading Fluency and Comprehension

Morrow Elementary School Goals

By May 2018, all students will understand addition and subtraction concepts to solve word problems. Students will read on grade level or higher. We will get there by:

- Teaching students to add and subtract 3 digit numbers with re-grouping.
- Improving DIBELS Oral Reading Fluency to 87 with 97% accuracy
- Practicing 40 Phonemic Sounds
- Increasing each students Lexile level from 100 to 500

When teachers, students, and families work together, we CAN achieve our goals!

Teachers, Parents, Students Working Together - A Recipe for Success!

2nd grade Teachers will:

- Send home weekly learning agenda with vocabulary words.
- Communicate with parents daily via student folder.
- Provide parents with addition and subtraction activities to use at home.
- Write in journal every morning.
- Review sight words in small groups
- Provide websites for parents to use at home

At Home

Morrow Elementary School parents joined staff to develop ideas about how families can support students' success in Reading.

- Maintain positive communication with the teacher and school staff by checking my child's backpack /folder each day and respond in a timely manner.
- Use flash cards to help my child learn basic addition and subtraction facts
- Read with my child 30 minutes or more each day.
- Review vocabulary words

Morrow Elementary School Students

Morrow Elementary School students joined staff and parents to develop ideas about how they can succeed in school. Students thought of the following ideas to make connections between learning at home and school:

- Review vocabulary words each day.
- Complete addition and subtraction activities at home.
- Read 30 minutes each day.
- Complete homework assignments.
- Stay on task and be prepared to learn

Communication about Student Learning


Morrow Elementary School is committed to two-way communication with families about children's learning. Some ways you can expect us to communicate with you are:
