To make your comic strip work, you will need to create six panels – a Sunday comic.

(A Sunday comic, you might recall, is always color; yours should be colored too.)

Each panel will represent one of the six points on the plot line - exposition, inciting moment, rising action, climax, falling action, and resolution. To show mastery of the list 3 vocabulary, you must correctly use each vocabulary word at least one time.

- Each box should include:
 - Summary of the plot point (2-3 sentences)
 - Direct quote from the text (woven into your own sentence)
 - o Illustration

****You may invent short bits of dialogue to put inside the boxes** -- extra points**
