

		<ul> <li>Held memberships in a state-recognized Career and Technical Student Organization (CTSO) during high school</li> <li>Prepare a portfolio to include a cover letter, resume, and three letters of recommendation</li> <li>AND THREE of the following:</li> <li>Connect with local businesses to secure support for the student's local CTSO project (i.e. through sponsorship, judging at conferences, and/or in-kind donations, etc.)</li> <li>Advocate for local CTSOs by presenting to civic organizations, legislators, and/or local, state, or national board of education members</li> <li>Receive a regional, state, or national honor and/or recognition</li> <li>Participate in at least 40 hours of documented community service, and/or community service campaigns (i.e. March of Dimes)</li> <li>Distinguished Leadership Skills Seal:</li> <li>Held a leadership office at the regional, state or national level in state-recognized CTSO during high school</li> <li>Participate in at least 80 hours of documented community service, and/or community service campaigns (i.e. March of Dimes)</li> </ul>

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	<ul> <li>Society (GNHS), or Latin National Honor Society (LHS)</li> <li>✓ Completion of a minimum of two Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB), or Dual Enrollment (DE) courses</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>International Skills Diploma:</li> <li>✓ At least three credits in the same world language</li> <li>✓ At least four credits in International Focus courses (see approved IF course list from DOE)</li> <li>✓ At least four extracurricular activities and experiences with global themes and/or in global contexts (e.g. exchange programs, international and language clubs, travel abroad, etc.)</li> <li>✓ At least twenty hours of community service involving a global/cross-cultural public service project</li> <li>✓ Capstone presentation on the knowledge gained in the courses and activities</li> </ul>
