

		 Held memberships in a state-recognized Career and Technical Student Organization (CTSO) during high school Prepare a portfolio to include a cover letter, resume, and three letters of recommendation AND THREE of the following: Connect with local businesses to secure support for the student's local CTSO project (i.e. through sponsorship, judging at conferences, and/or in-kind donations, etc.) Advocate for local CTSOs by presenting to civic organizations, legislators, and/or local, state, or national board of education members Receive a regional, state, or national honor and/or recognition Participate in at least 40 hours of documented community service, and/or community service campaigns (i.e. March of Dimes) Distinguished Leadership Skills Seal: Held a leadership office at the regional, state or national level in state-recognized CTSO during high school Participate in at least 80 hours of documented community service, and/or community service campaigns (i.e. March of Dimes)
