Graduation Requirements

Reminder-It starts now!

- In order to graduate, students in Florida must earn a minimum of 24 credits:
 - 4 credits in English
 - 4 credits in mathematics (Algebra 1 & Geometry)
 - 3 credits in science (Biology)
 - 3 credits in social studies (World History, American History, Government & Economics)
 - 1 credit in a fine art
 - 1 credit in HOPE (Health Opportunities in Physical Education)
 - 1 online or virtual blended class (HOPE, Digital Design 1, Intro to IT are virtual blended)
 - 8 Elective credits (Including academic electives)
- Earn a 2.0 unweighted grade point average (gpa)
- Pass (level 3 or higher) 10th grade Florida Standards Assessment in Reading & Writing. Pass the Algebra 1 State End of Course exam
- Take Geometry, Biology, and American History State End of Course exams. Each State EOC exam counts as 30% of the overall course grade.

GRADES

- Every course grade earned counts in the GPA and will be seen by a college on the high school transcript.
- Freshman year is the MOST important in establishing a good GPA.
- In courses with a State EOC – the final course grade counts in the GPA calculation.
- In all other courses, the final semester grade counts in the GPA calculation. The final semester grade includes grades for 2 quarters and semester exam.
