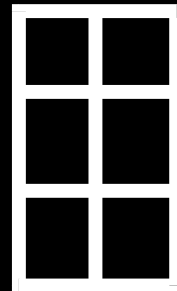
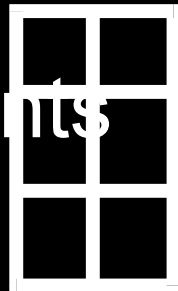

Graduation Requirements

■ Personal Fitness/Health (1 Credit)

- 3 semesters of JROTC may substitute for this requirement
- 1 Credit PE/Health

■ CTAE/Fine Arts/Foreign Language Electives (3 Credits)

- Students planning to enter into a University System of Georgia Institution must take two units of the same foreign language. We offer Spanish and French.

We recommend students in Accelerated Math and Honors English classes take Foreign Language as 10th graders. All other students can take in the 11th or 12th grades.

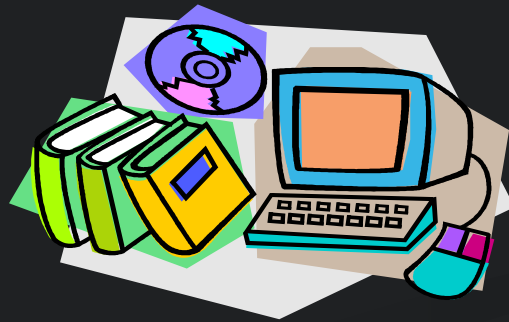
