- 6th and 7th Grade students will take the End of Grade Assessment for Language Arts and Math.
- 8th Grade students will take the End of Grade Assessment for Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies.
- 8th Grade students that do not pass the Language Arts or Math assessment will participate in EOG Retest June 4th— June 8th.
- 8th Grade Gifted/AP students that are enrolled in 9th Grade Algebra will take the Algebra End of Course test instead of the 8th Grade Math End of Grade test.
- All assessments will begin in the morning. It is important that students arrive to school on time and are present on all test days.
- Students should not be signed out of school early on test dates except for an emergency. Testing could potentially run into the afternoon and students cannot leave a test session until all students are finished.
- Please encourage your child to get plenty of sleep and eat a healthy breakfast each morning before testing. School breakfast is free for all students!
- All students will take the assessments online again this year.
