### 2021-2022 Secondary School Report

The Cherokee County School District (CCSD) is a high-performing public-school system in Metro Atlanta, with 40 schools and centers, 6,000 employees and approximately 42,200 students. CCSD is the ninth-largest school system in Georgia and is one of only 11 school districts in the Nation to be named an Innovative District for 2018 by The International Center for Leadership in Education.

River Ridge High School is located in Woodstock, Georgia, approximately 35 miles north of Atlanta. River Ridge was established in 2009 and graduated its first class in 2013. The graduating class in 2021 had 462 students, and River Ridge students and teachers have enjoyed numerous successes including raising the graduation rate, raising ACT and SAT scores, and being named an AP Humanities, AP Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics and AP STEM Achievement School in 2019. River Ridge has appeared on the Washington Post's "America's Most Challenging High Schools" list and is honored to be participating in the prestigious Chick-Fil-A Leadership Academy.

Extra-curricular and athletic accomplishments for River Ridge include: 10 athletic teams qualified to represent River Ridge in the GHSA State Playoffs with Region 7-AAAAAA Championships in Football (Elite 8), Girls Basketball (Final Four) and Baseball (Sweet 16). Girls Cross Country finished 6<sup>th</sup> in State with individual runners placing as high as 6<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> respectively. Girls Swim also placed 9<sup>th</sup> in State with a 2nd place finish in 100M Breaststroke, 4<sup>th</sup> in 200 IM, and 4<sup>th</sup> in 400 Free Relay.

RRHS is on a traditional 7 period schedule. The school year is divided into two semesters (August-December and January-May). Students take 6 classes per semester and can earn .5 credit per class totaling 3 credits per semester; 6 credits per year. An additional .5 elective credit may be earned by participating in and completing the assignments during Teachers as Advisors (TAA) that meets each Wednesday.

The school day is divided into seven fifty-five-minute periods which meet five days per week. Hours are 8:15 to 3:15. The school year began on August 2, 2021 and ends on May 27, 2022. First semester began on August 2, 2021; second semester on January 4, 2022.

River Ridge currently offers students the Georgia Department of Education International Skills Diploma Seal, the Georgia Seal of Biliteracy, six different career pathway seals, and the Fine Arts Diploma Seal.

All transcripts reflect the grade earned *before* any quality points are added.

Class rank is determined by the weighted cumulative numeric grade average (NGA) of graduating seniors at the completion of their graduation requirements.

These averages are placed in numerical order from highest to lowest to determine class rank. All classes are included when calculating NGA and class rank.
