- Large “pools” funds are not allowed (e.g. Contract with a vendor (e.g. Solution Tree, UD, etc.) to offer PD to educators on math and reading). Be specific as to grade levels and include only one content area.
- Please do not combine different cost objectives in one budget item.
- Write out acronyms the first time.
- Charter and Vocational/Technical schools may skip the Equitable Services section.
- Two new questions have been added.
- Two additional assurances have been added.
