If your student is showing an interest in a certain subject and is willing to work hard, absolutely. If you still are unsure, consider enrolling your student in one advanced course in an area of interest.

3) Should I place my student in GEMS?

If your student completed PRIMES, has an affinity for Math and has the available time to complete the virtual component of the course, please enroll your student in GEMS.

4) My student has an IEP/504/EP. What courses should my student take?

Please list the courses that you feel your student will do well in. Any additional services needed will be discussed at the upcoming articulation meetings at the elementary school.
