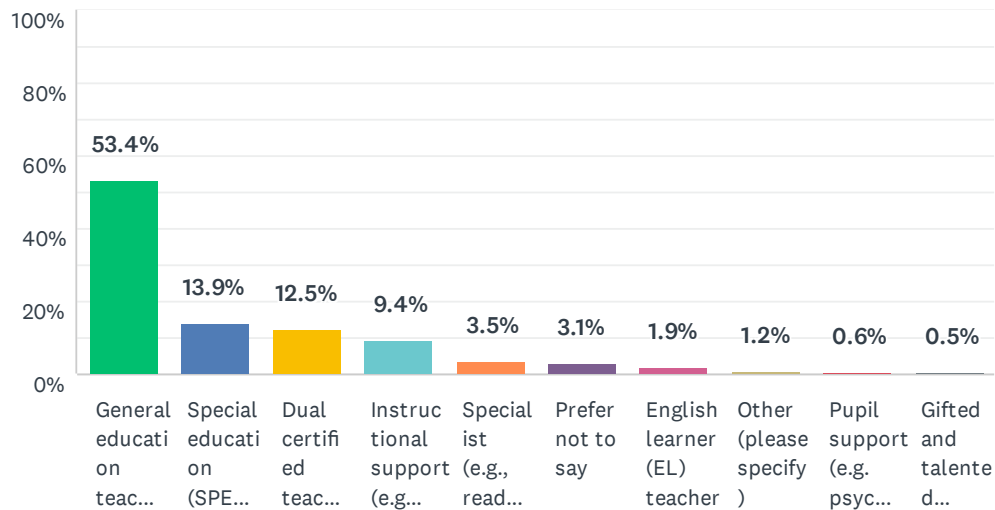

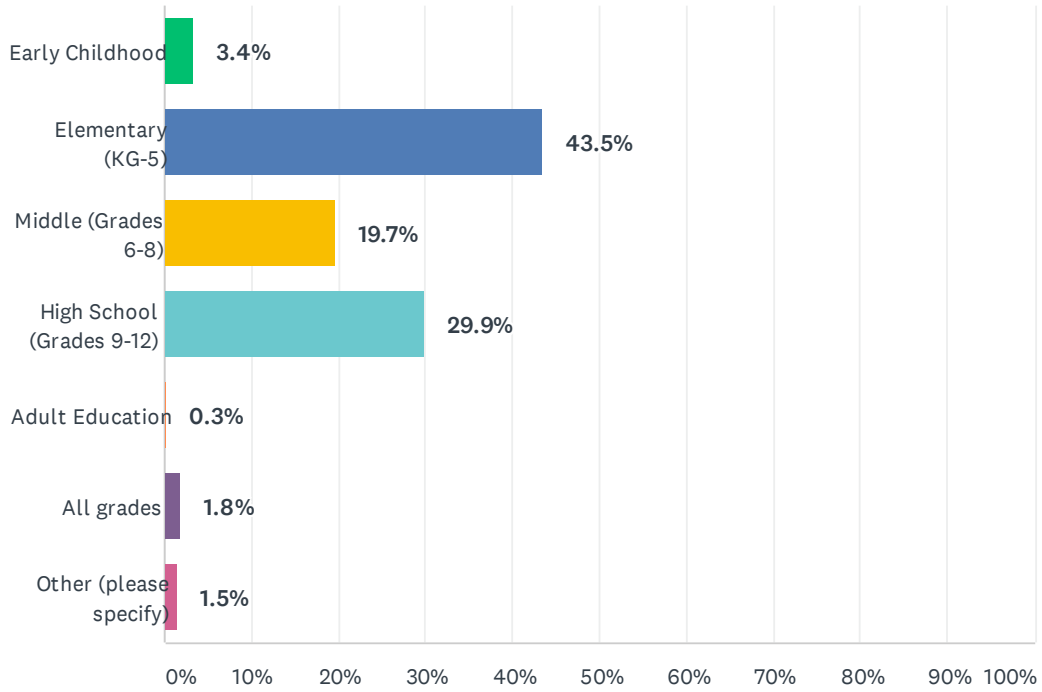

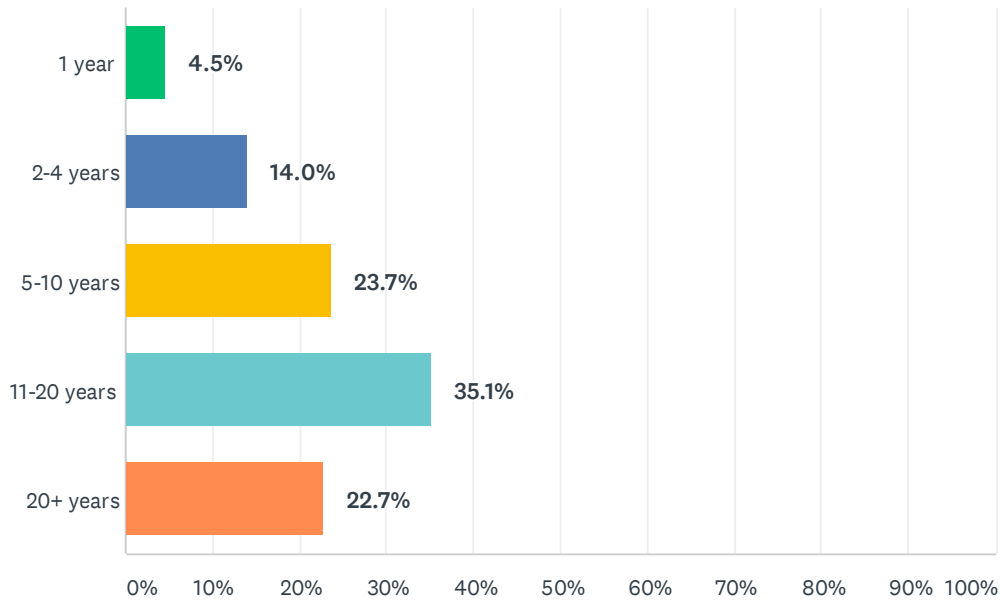

Q23 How many years have you been employed as a teacher?

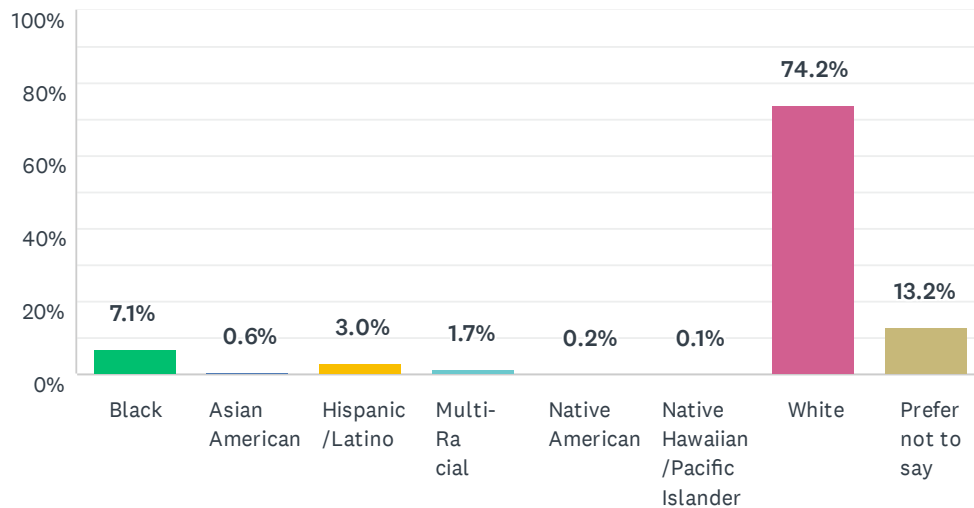

Q24 What is your race/ethnicity?

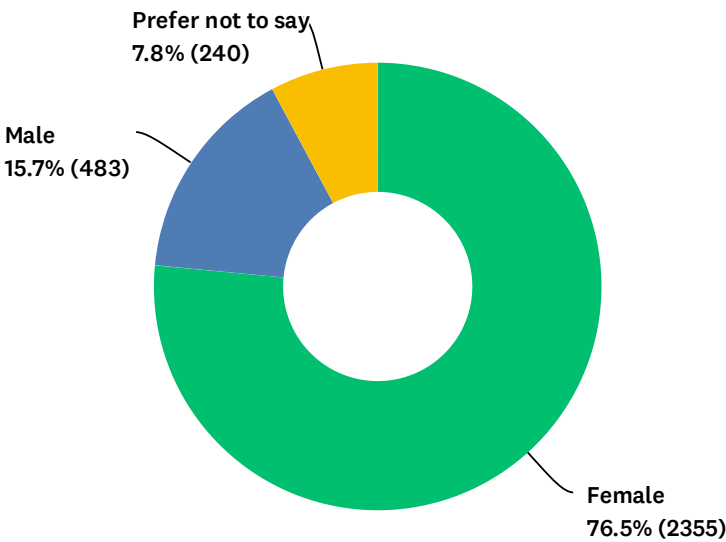

Q25 What is your gender?

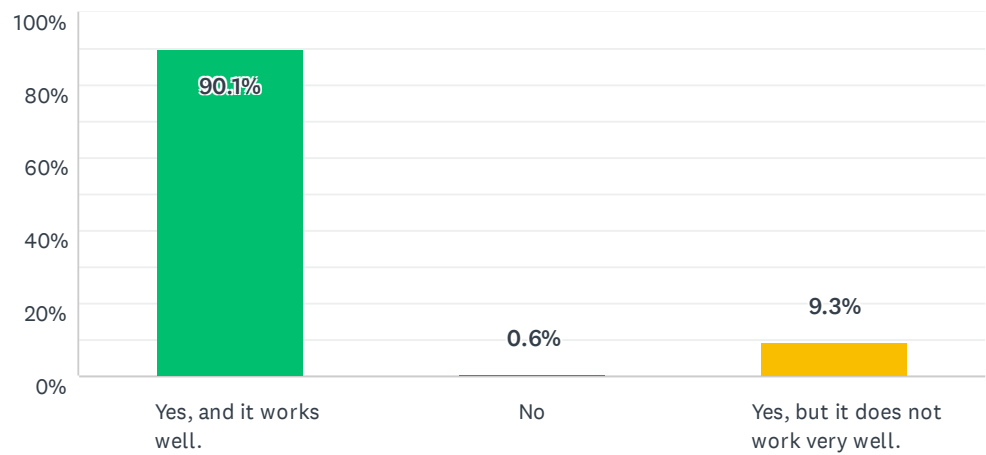

Q26 Do you have internet access at home?

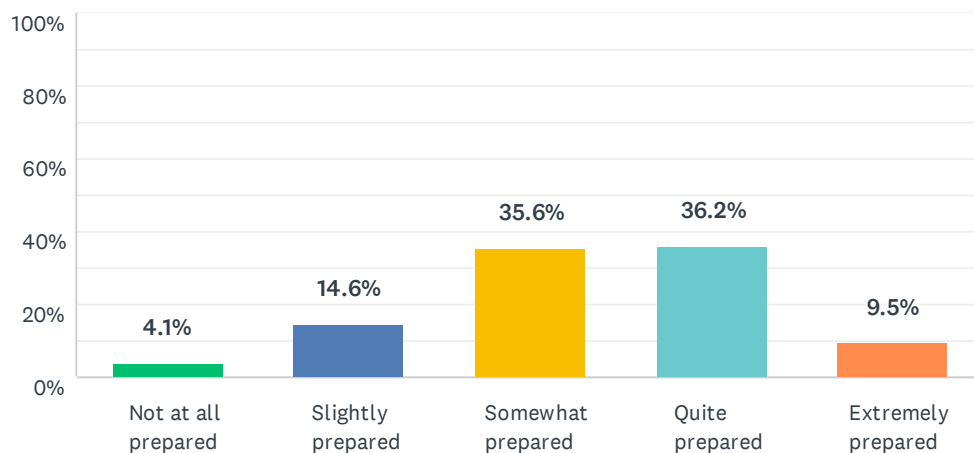

Q27 How prepared did you feel to use the technology and programs that were set up for you to use for instruction this year?

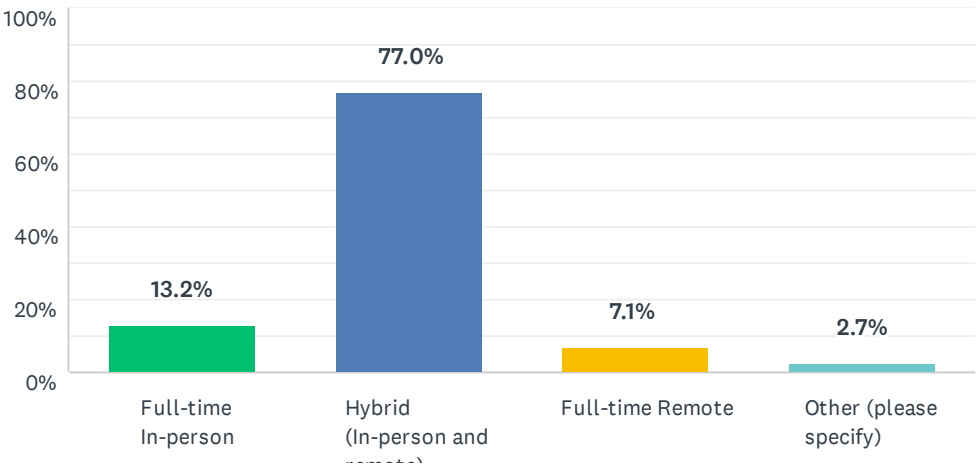

Q28 How are you currently delivering instruction?

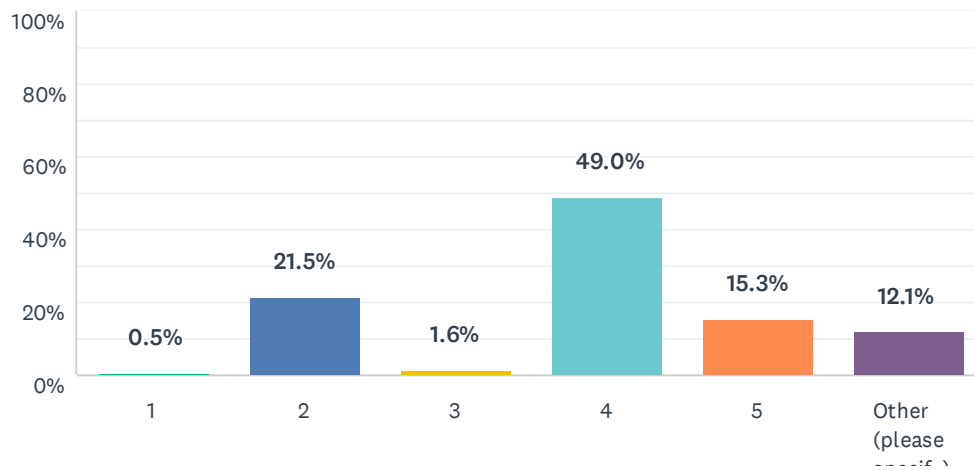

Q29 In the last week, if the students were not fully remote, how many days did students attend school?

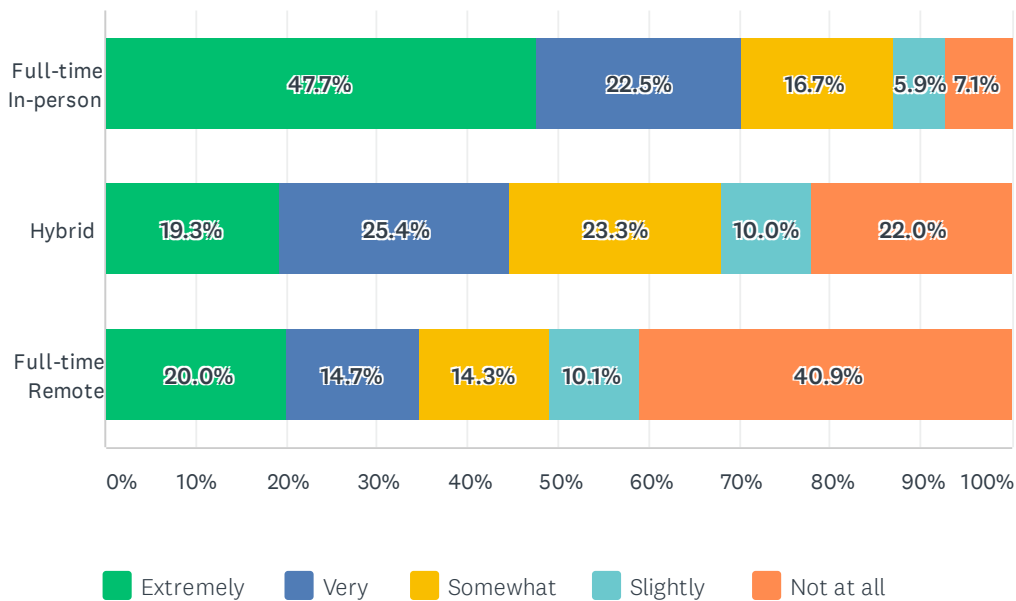

Q30 Given the current conditions, how comfortable would you be with the following choices of delivering instruction at the beginning of next school year (2021-2022)?

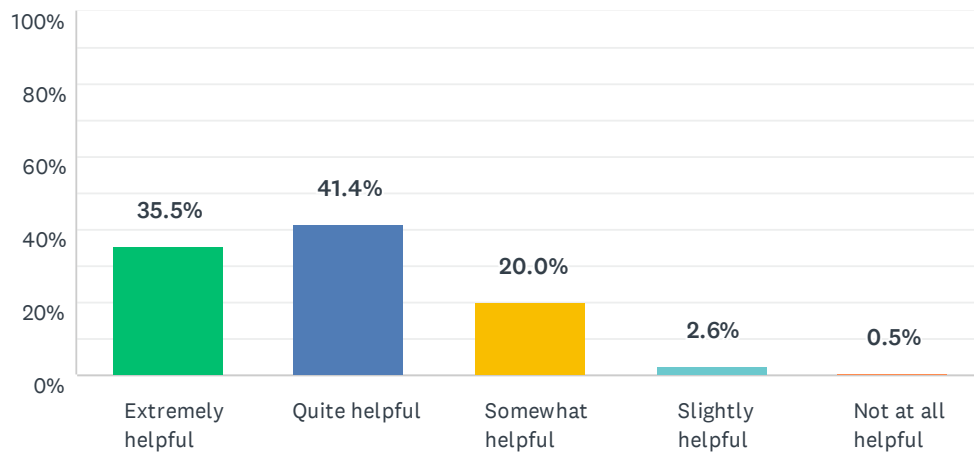

Q32 How helpful have you been in supporting your student's academic needs this year?

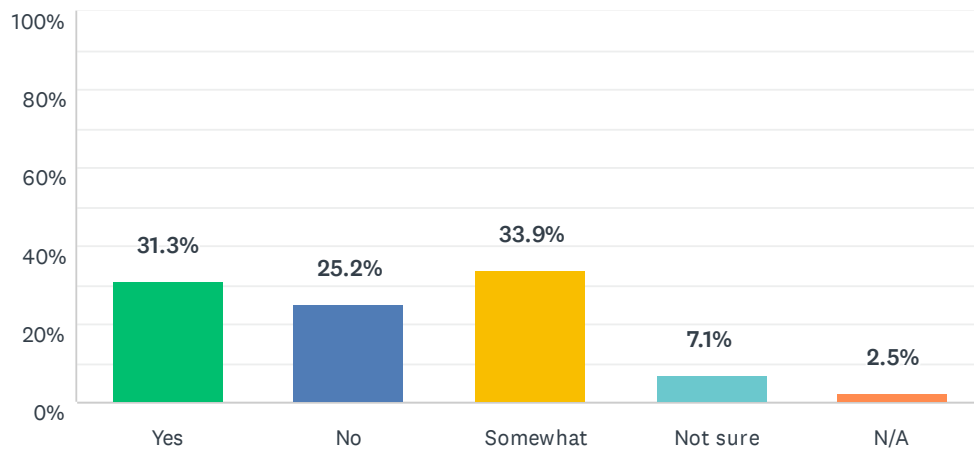

Q33 Have you remained as effective in your role this school year as you were before COVID-19?

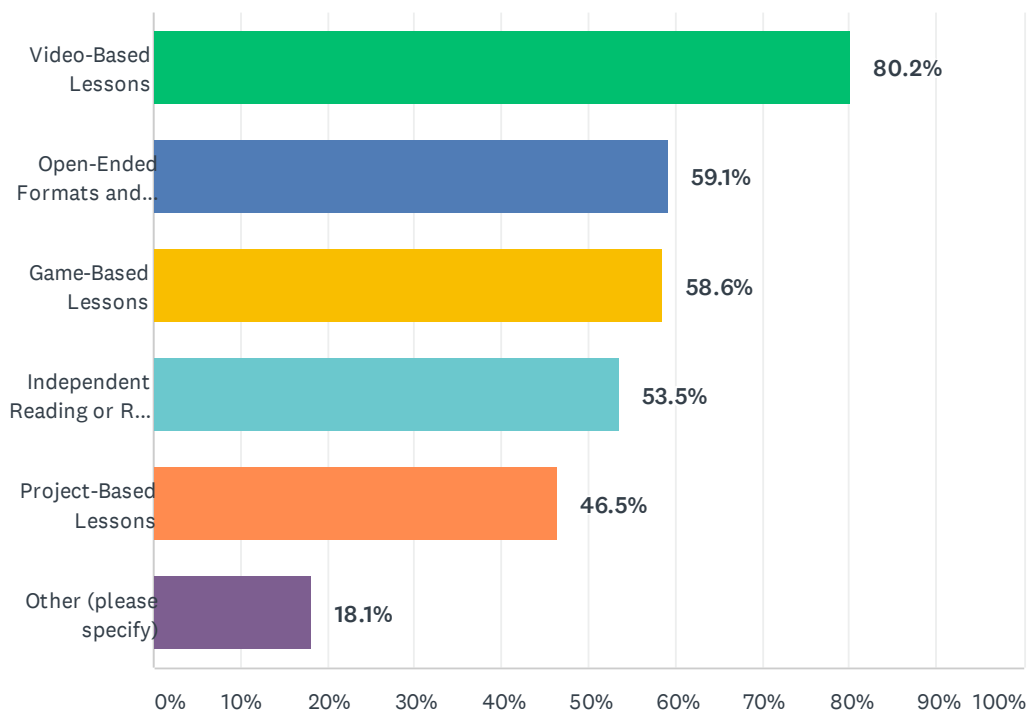

Q34 What did you do to make the lessons engaging for students (select all that apply)?

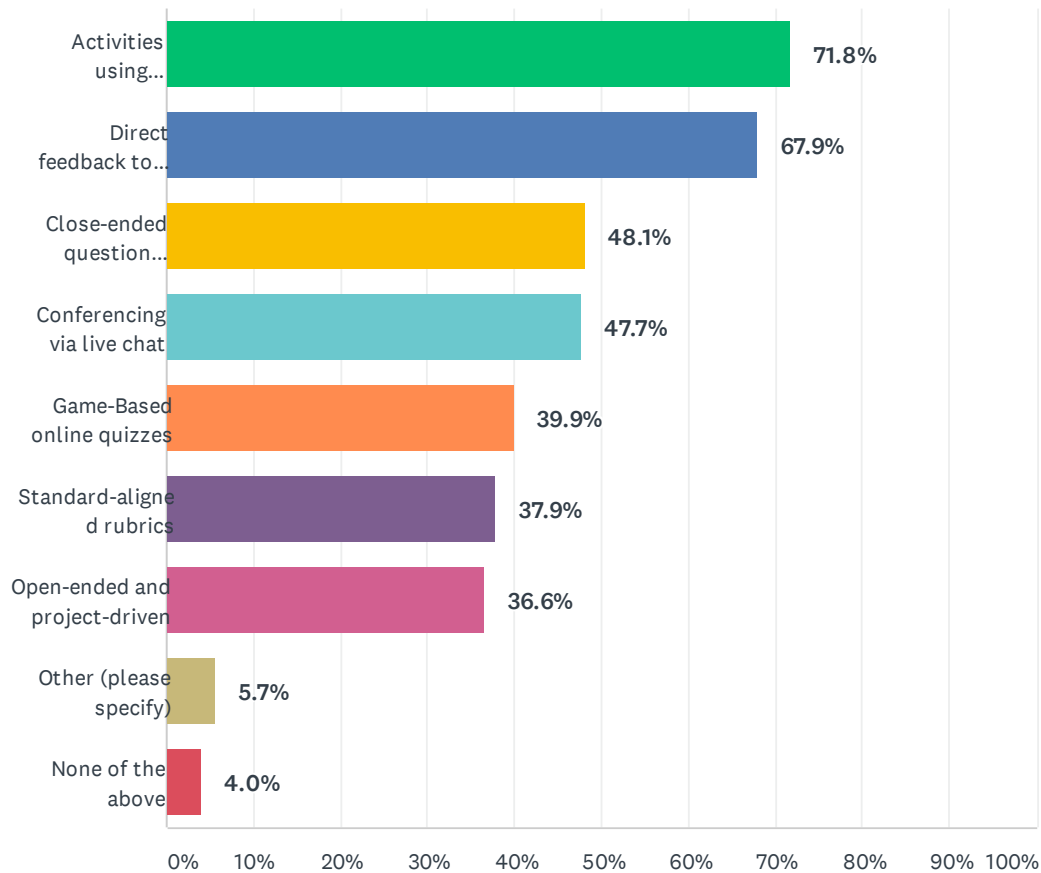

Q35 What formative assessment methods have you found effective (check all that apply)?

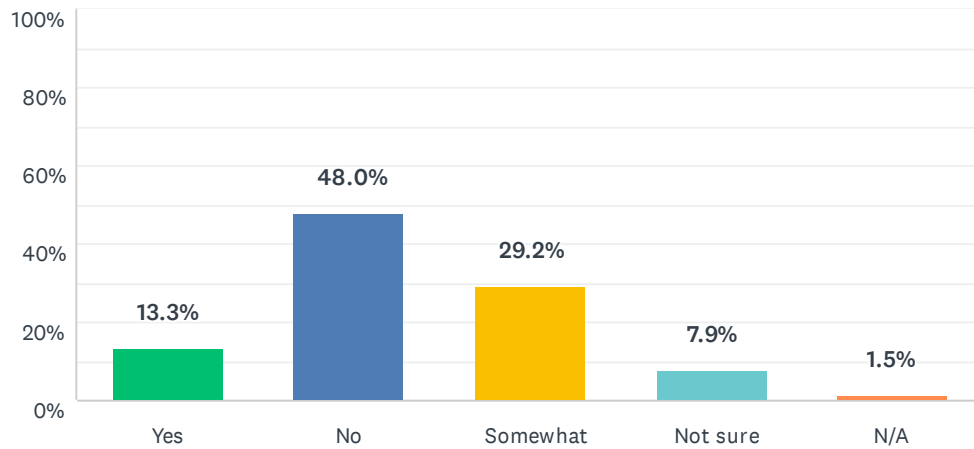

Q36 Are your students learning as much now as they were prior to COVID-19?

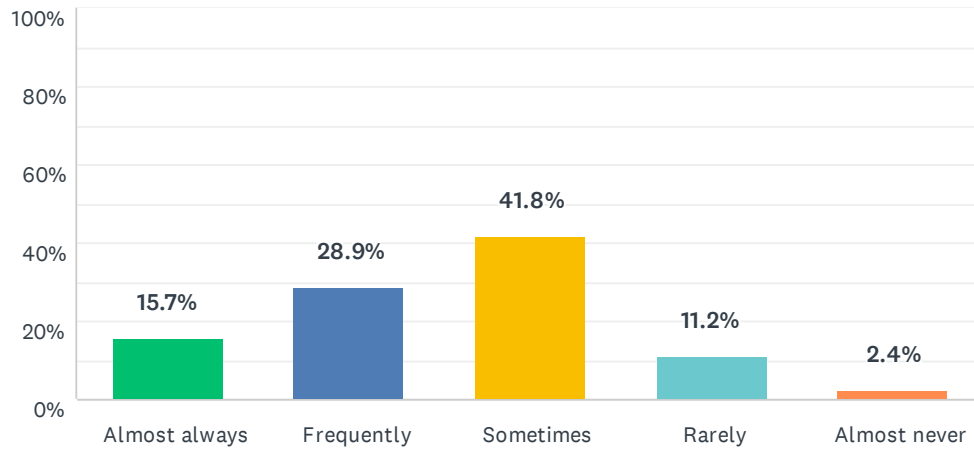

Q37 How motivated have your students been to attend classes this year?

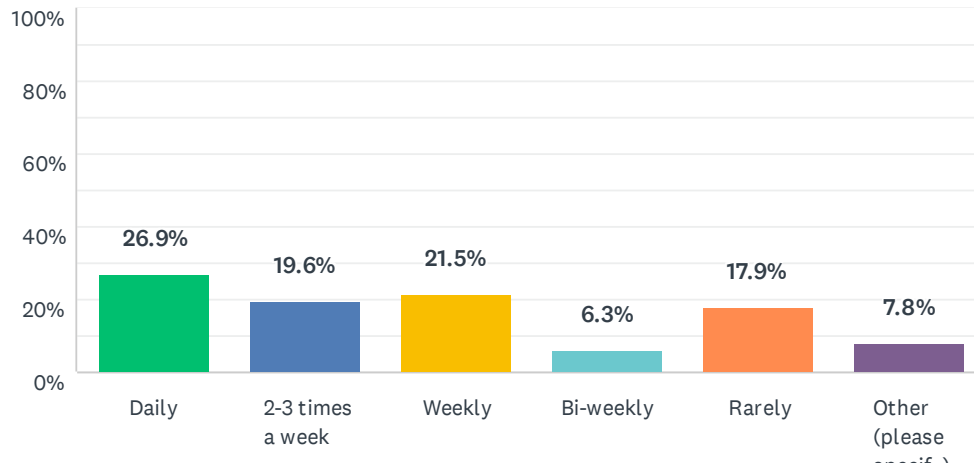

Q38 How often do you provide opportunities for students to collaborate?

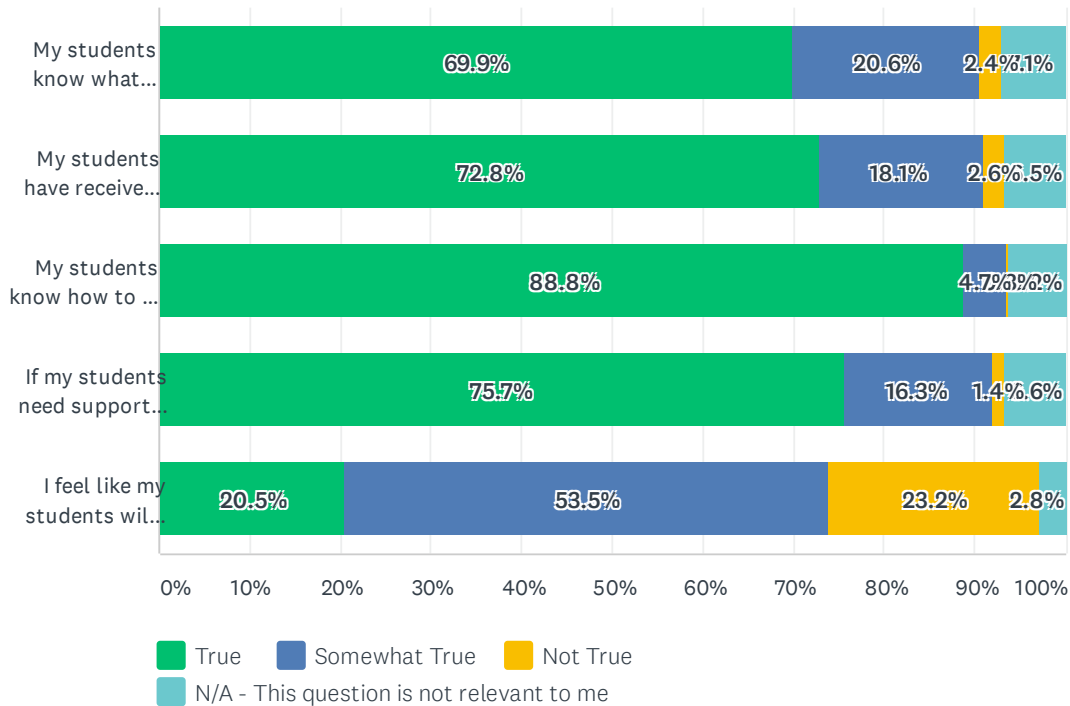

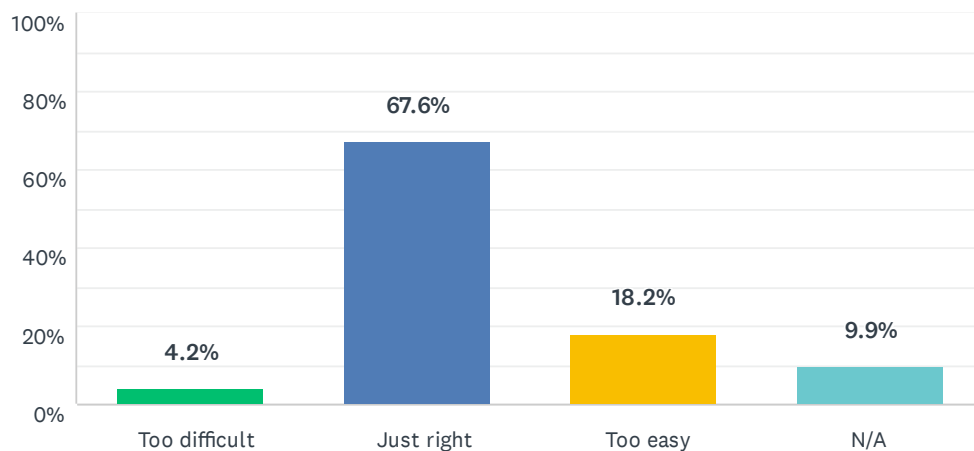

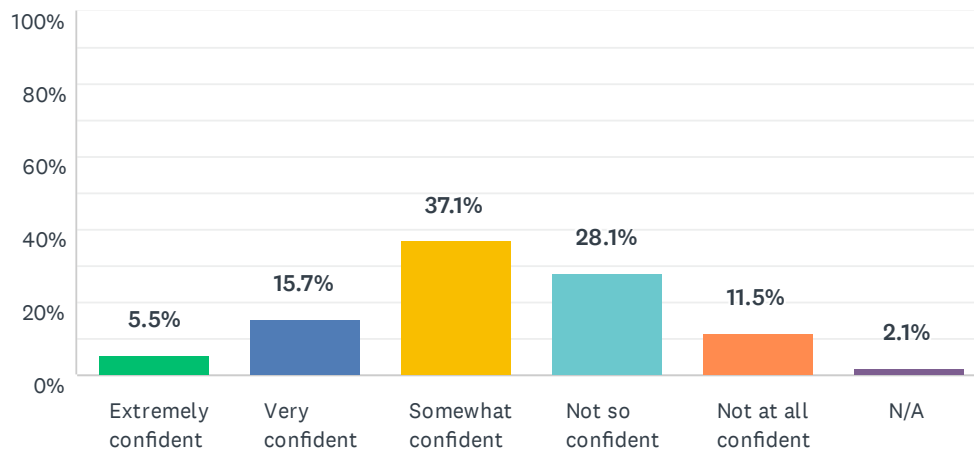

Q42 For your students who need the most academic support, how confident are you that you can help those students in a hybrid/remote learning setting?

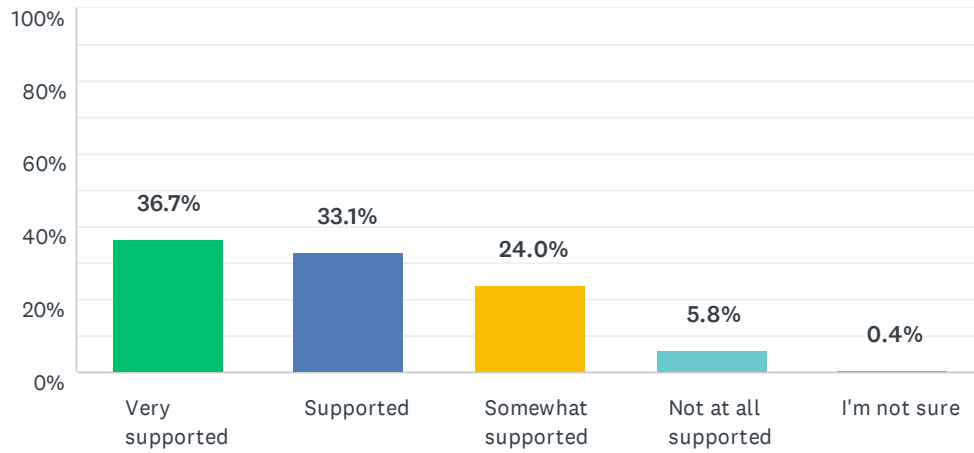

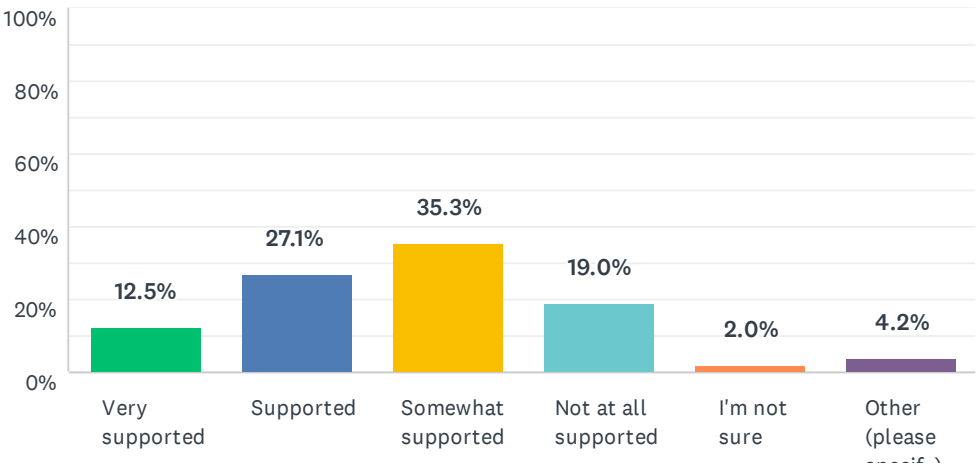

Q45 How supported do you feel by your district leaders?

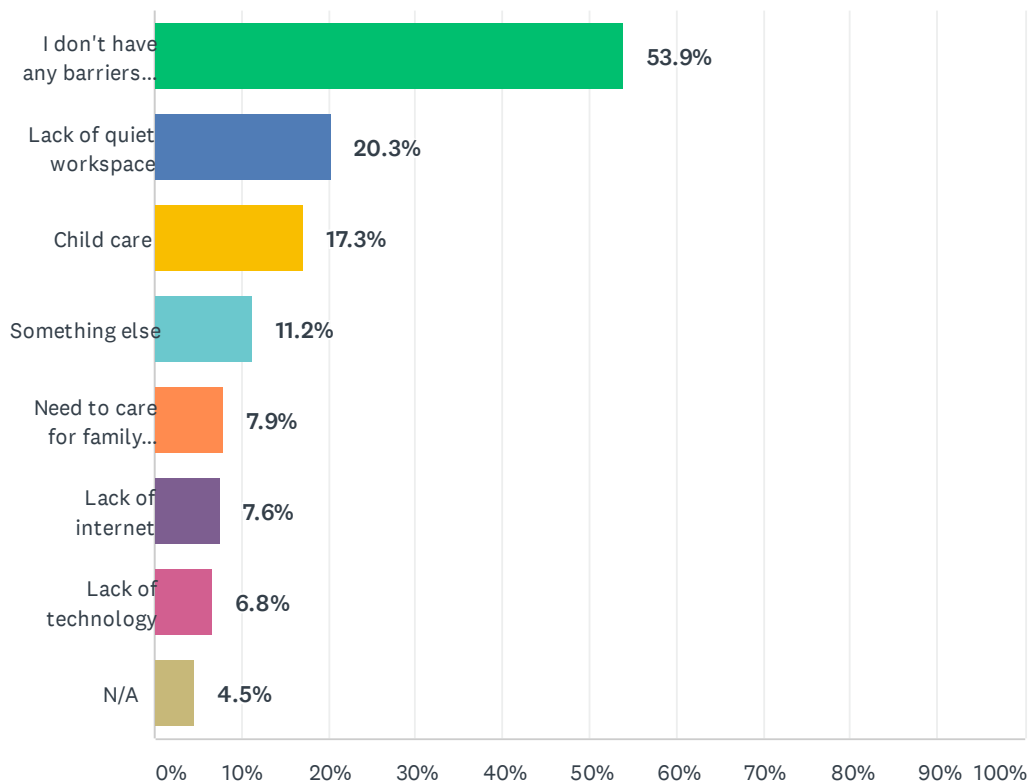

Q46 What is your biggest barrier in effectively working from home? (select up to three)

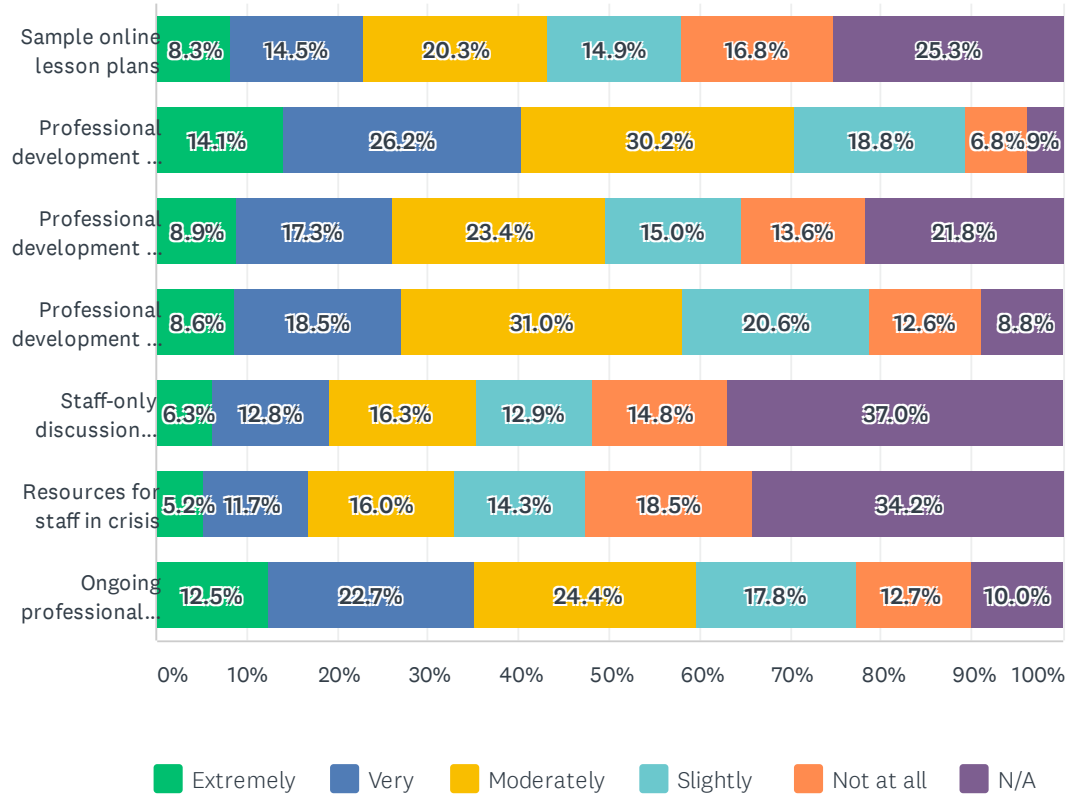

Q47 How useful were the resources and supports provided to you?

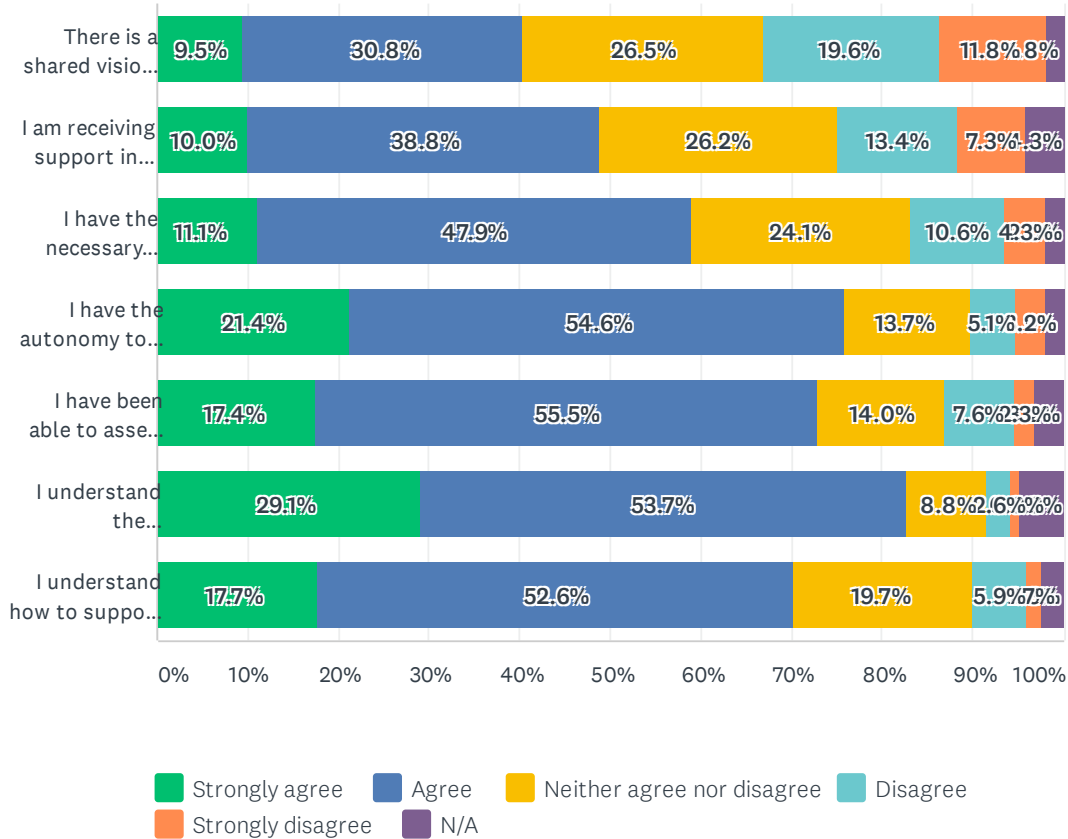

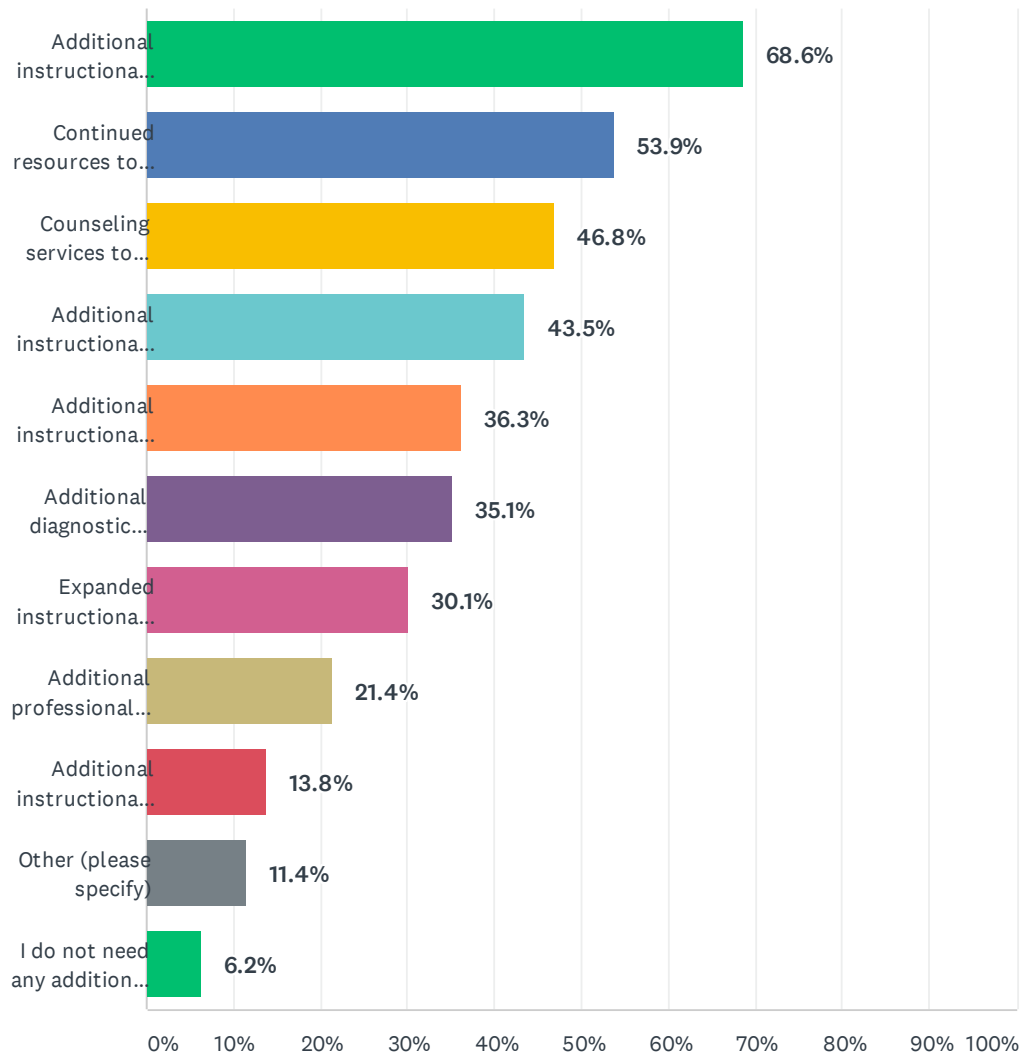

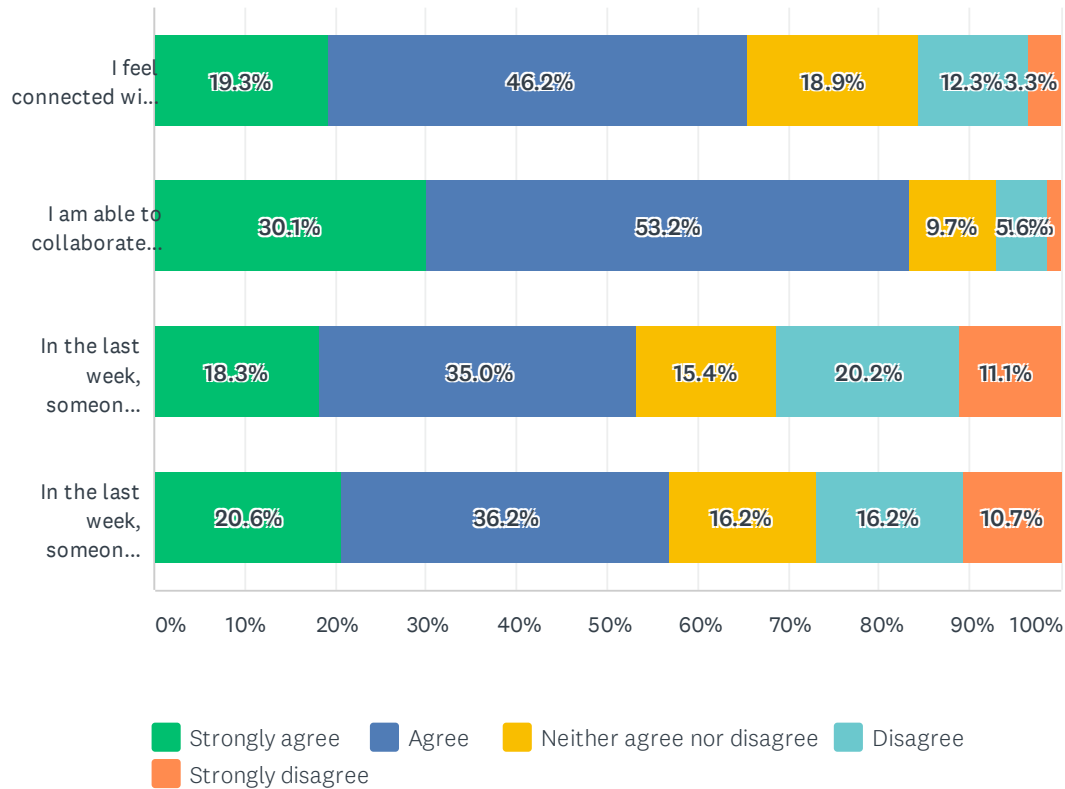

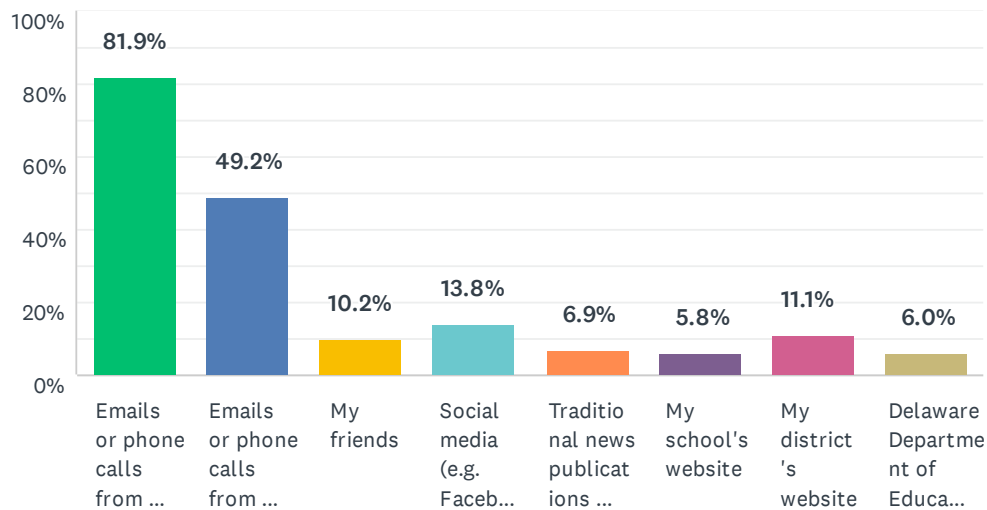

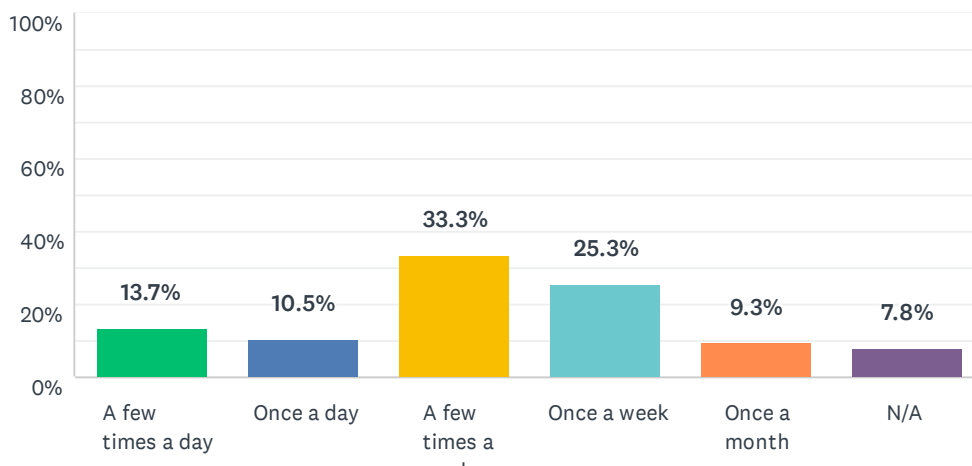

Q55 During this school year, how often did you communicate with your students' families/guardians?

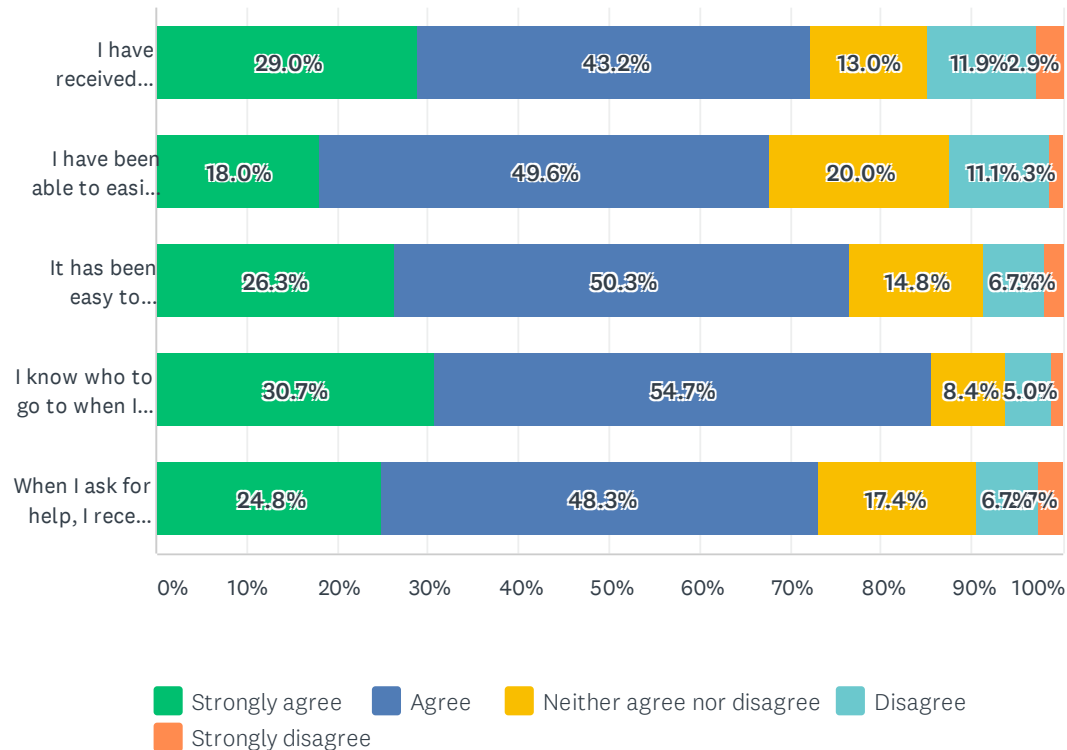

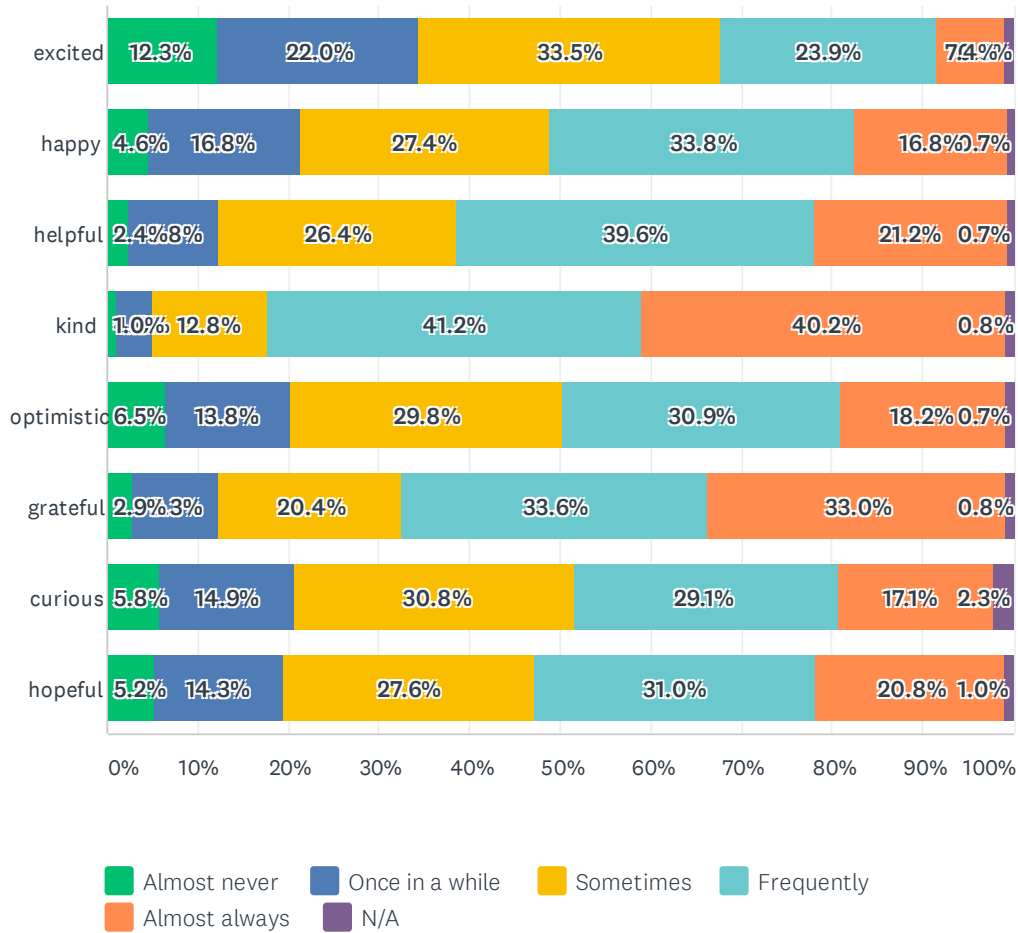
