August 11-August 19	Biology Pre-Test	Pre-test for all students enrolled in biology. Testing will take place during the class period.
August 15-August 26	STAR Assessments #1 Algebra 1 & Geometry	Progress monitoring #1 for all students enrolled in Algebra 1 and Geometry. Testing will take place during the class period.
August 29- September 2	Write Score Test #1	9 <sup>th</sup> grade ELA students will test Monday and Tuesday. 10 <sup>th</sup> grade ELA students will test Thursday and Friday. Classes will relocate to the media center and teachers will administer the tests.
September 6-September 9	ELA FAST Progress Monitoring #1	Progress monitoring #1 for all students enrolled in ELA 9 and 10. Testing will take place during the class period in the media center.
September 12-September 13	FSA ELA-Writing & Reading Retakes	11 <sup>th</sup> & 12 <sup>th</sup> grade students who have not met the FSA ELA Writing/Reading graduation requirement
September 19-September 23	FSA/NGSSS EOCs Retakes Algebra 1, Geometry Biology, US History	Students who attempted but did not meet the graduation requirement for Algebra 1, Geometry*, Biology, US History EOCs. <i>*Final administration of the Geometry EOC Assessment aligned to the Florida Standards. Subsequent administrations of the Geometry EOC Assessment will be aligned to the B.E.S.T. Standards.</i>
September 26-October 14	FSAA Make-ups/Retakes for 10 <sup>th</sup> grade ELA 2 and Algebra 1.	Students who are enrolled in the Access Points curriculum.
September-October	FSAA-Datafolio Collection Period #1: ELA Reading; EOCs (Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology, Civics, US History	Students who are enrolled in the Access Points curriculum.



October 3-October 6	1 <sup>st</sup> Quarter Exams	1 <sup>st</sup> Quarter Exams (all county benchmark progress monitoring assessments)
October 12	SAT/PSAT School Day	All 9 <sup>th</sup> – 11 <sup>th</sup> grade students will participate in the PSAT/NMSQT. All 12 <sup>th</sup> grade students will participate in the SAT (reportable).
October 27	SAT Non-college reportable	12 <sup>th</sup> grade students who sign up for the non-reportable version for concordance.
November 1	ACT School Day	All 11 <sup>th</sup> grade students (reportable). 12 <sup>th</sup> grade students that have not yet met their math and/or FSA ELA graduation requirement (reportable and non-college reportable available)
November 14	Florida Civic Literacy Exam	All 12 <sup>th</sup> grade students enrolled in US Government.
November 28-December 9	FSA/NGSSS EOC Retakes Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology, US History	Students who attempted but did not meet the graduation requirement for Algebra 1*, Geometry*, Biology, US History EOCs. <i>*The Algebra 1 and Geometry EOC assessments will be aligned to Florida's B.E.S.T. Standards.</i>
December 13-December 16	2 <sup>nd</sup> Quarter Exams	2 <sup>nd</sup> Quarter Exams (all county benchmark progress monitoring assessments, Biology Mid-Test: 9-10).
