#### **How is it revised?**

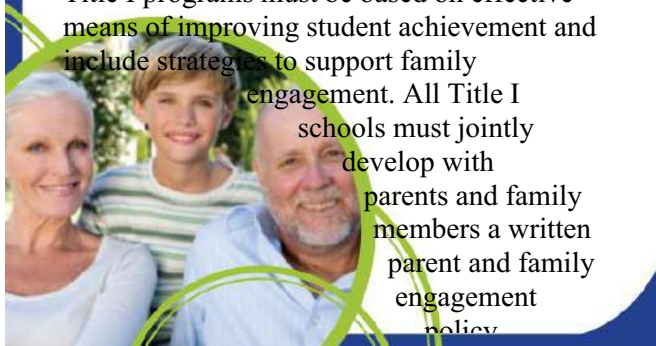
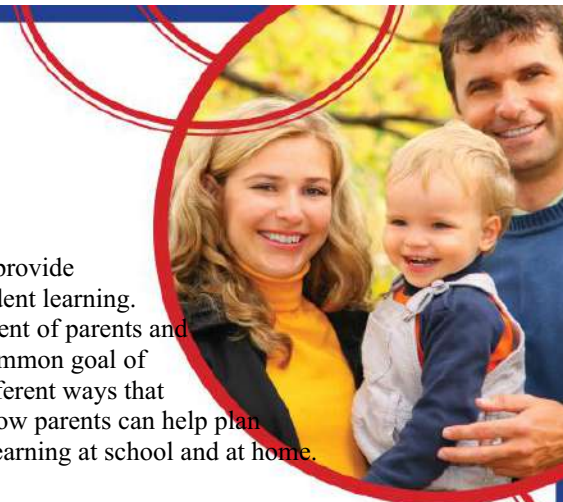

#### **Who is it for?**

All students participating in the Title I, Part A program, and their families are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. Ben Hill Elementary will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents and family members with limited English, with disabilities, and of migratory children.

Parents will meet with teachers and staff and receive information about the Georgia Milestones and complete an online practice session to see how students are tested.

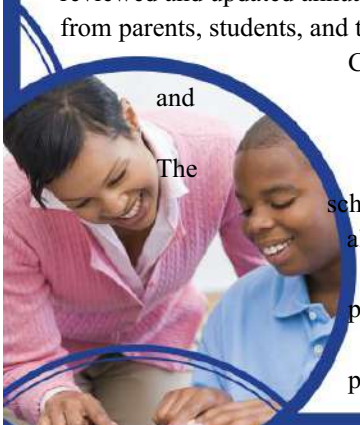
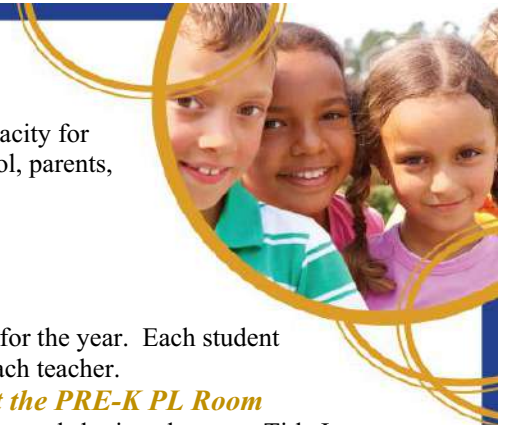
