RIVEROAK Technical College provides high school students with the opportunity to take technical classes (electives) while taking required academic courses at their high school. Students receive industry level training in work environment labs. High school students are exempt from paying tuition while enrolled in high school.

**Attendance-** High School students will be expected to follow the attendance policy of the high school.

Suwannee High School students have the opportunity to take Career Dual Enrollment classes at RIVEROAK Technical College. These classes lead to either industry certification or licensure. Enrollment is on a space available basis to high school students who have a minimum 2.0 GPA. Classes are part of their normal 6 period day but taught on the campus of RIVEROAK, which is across the street from SHS. Dual enrollment students are taught along with adult college students. Carpentry/ Building Construction \_\_\_\_\_ Instructor Derwin Bass

Students learn all concepts of carpentry and building construction. Students are very involved in the very popular RIVEROAK playhouse projects

Applied Cybersecurity \_\_\_\_\_ Instructor William Hill

This course provides knowledge in computer and network security, security vulnerabilities, intrusion detection and prevention. Students who complete the course sequence can earn the CompTIA A+ and Security Certification.

Medical Administrative Specialist \_\_\_\_\_ Instructor Teresa Gill

This course prepares students for employment as an administrative assistant with the specialty of medical terminology. Students will earn certification in the Microsoft bundle as well as Certified Medical Administration Assistant. With the completion of this program.

Automotive Service Technician \_\_\_\_\_ Instructor BJ Blackmon

Students learn how to work on car engines, transmissions, brakes and all aspects of auto mechanics. Students have the opportunity to earn multiple ASE certifications.

Automotive Collision Technology Technician \_\_\_\_\_ Instructor Joe Ragan

Students learn all aspects of automobile body damage repair. This course includes bodywork, welding and painting. Students explore painting techniques from functional to creative.

Brick and Block Masonry 1 \_\_\_\_\_ Instructor Derwin Bass

Students learn all concepts of masonry. Students are very involved in the very popular RIVEROAK playhouse projects. This program has had students compete at the national level of SkillsUSA.

Electricity 1 \_\_\_\_\_ Instructor Jeremy Ulmer

Students earn NCCER certifications in residential, commercial and industrial electrical work. They learn how to program circuit boards, CNC machine and 3-D printer.

Engineering Technology \_\_\_\_\_ Instructor Jeremy Ulmer

Students explore aspects of engineering. Students will study NASA, introductory computer programming and building design. They build challenging and exciting projects. Student will become certified in Solid Works.
