WHAT ARE THE RIGHT PLACEMENT OPTIONS FOR MY CHILD?



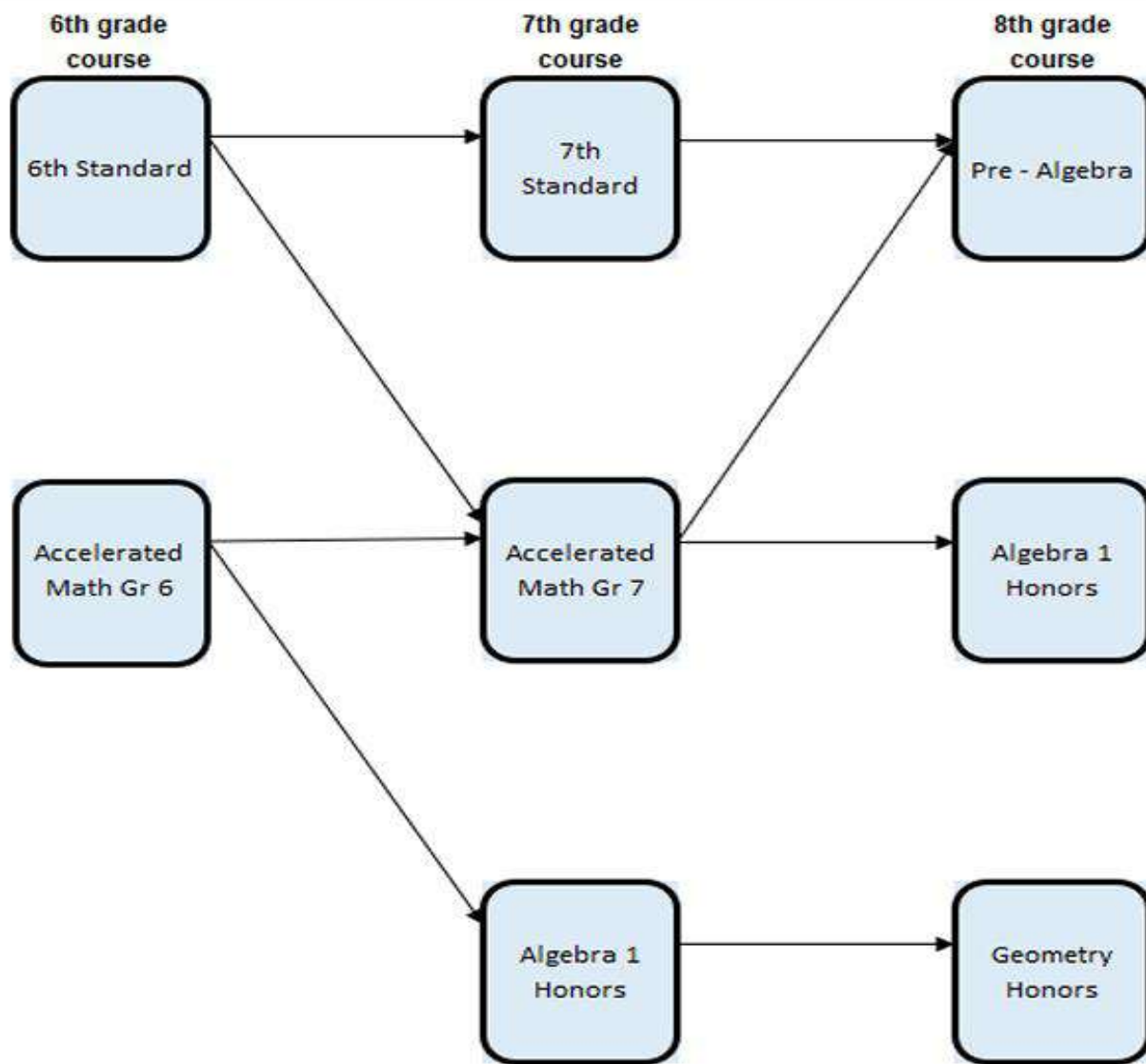
- PVA OFFERS CLASS LEVELS FOR MIDDLE GRADES STUDENTS DEPENDING ON THEIR INDIVIDUALIZED LEARNING PATH:
 - STANDARD, ADVANCED, AND FOR SOME SUBJECTS, HIGH SCHOOL HONORS
 - STANDARD AND ADVANCED CLASSES TEACH THE SAME STANDARDS. ADVANCED SECTIONS MAY GO IN MORE DEPTH, HIGHER LEVEL ANALYZING/CRITICAL THINKING, AND MAY MOVE THROUGH SOME CONTENT FASTER.
 - TAKING STANDARD COURSES IN MIDDLE SCHOOL DOES NOT MEAN THAT YOUR CHILD WON'T QUALIFY FOR ACCELERATED HIGH SCHOOL CLASSES.

If a student is required to take Intensive Reading or Intensive Math, the second and/or third elective (non-core) course may be replaced with these necessary intervention courses.

COURSE RECOMMENDATIONS & ELECTIVE REQUESTS

- Beginning tonight, you will be able to view course placements in HAC for the 2023-2024 school year. These placements will be based on the teacher recommendations, formative and summative assessments, previous FSA/FAST scores, and student performance in the classroom throughout this school year.
- You should be logged in as your child to see this.
- In HAC, you will then request ONE elective with your child. If you have more than one middle schooler next year, please log in separately and select in each account.
- There will not be an option to select electives that require pre-approval.
- If you have concerns about your child's academic course placements, please first reach out to your child's current teacher in that subject. You may wish to continue the conversation with Ms. Ferguson or an administrator. Requests to change course placements will be considered but are not guaranteed.

DIRECTIONS FOR ELECTIVE REQUEST ENTRY VIA STUDENT HOME ACCESS CENTER (HAC)

1. Log into Home Access Center (HAC) with your child's login ID and password.
2. In HAC, select the **Classes** icon.
3. Select the **Requests** tab.
4. You will see a list of Class Departments.
5. To choose a course, go to **Electives** and select the edit button on the right side. Click the box next to the desired course and hit save.
6. **Please do not choose more than one elective or try to make any changes to any other courses.**
7. Once you have made your selection, you can log off.
8. **The deadline to make your selections in HAC in is March 31st.**

- JAZZ BAND IS CODEPENDENT ON SYMPHONIC BAND





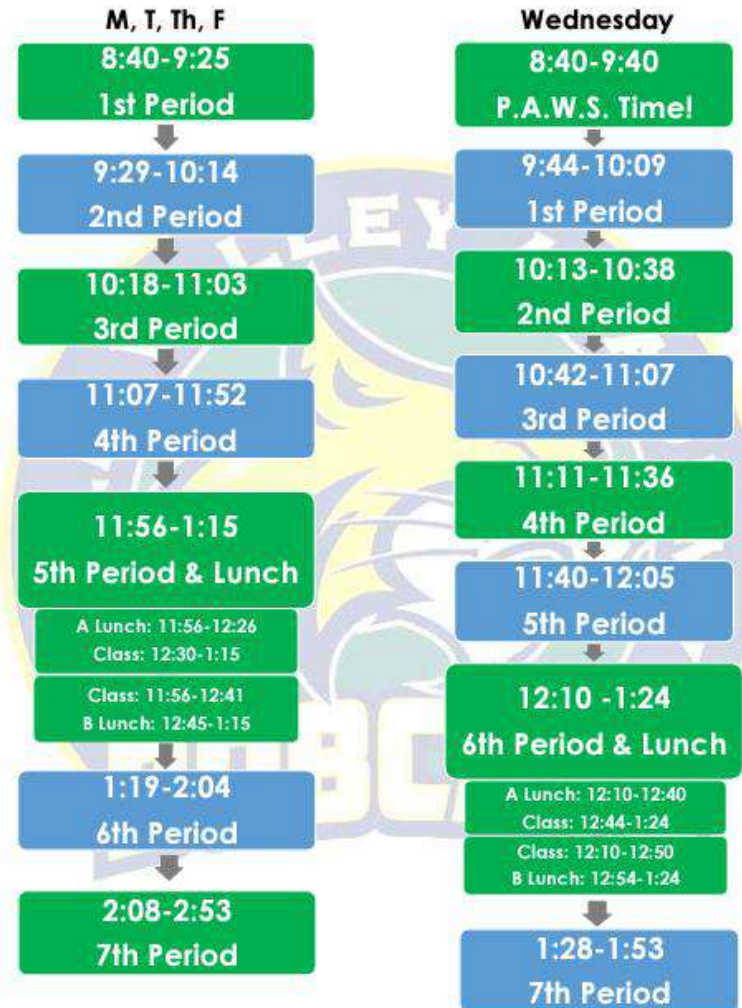
