### Residency

Applicants must be graduating seniors who have been students at the school for at least two years.

#### Academics

Applicants should have a GPA of 2.0 or higher and plan to attend an accredited two or 4-year College or University or a Certified Vocational or Technical Institute as a full-time student.

## Character

A fitting representative of their school, the student must be regarded as dependable and demonstrate respect for people, property, and the law. The student is also courteous, helpful, and caring in their relationships with other students, teachers, coaches, and adults.
