Middle school students are required to successfully complete three years of language arts, mathematics, science and social studies. Students who do not receive passing grades in their four core content classes (Math, ELA, Science and Social Studies) will be placed in course recovery.

Acceleration & Supports

We believe that with the right supports, ALL students have the ability to meet grade-level academic standards through challenging course work. Science and Mathematics are offered in regular and advanced options. Students may receive intensive reading or math supports in a co-teach setting based on student FSA scores.

Physical Education

All students are required to take 1 Semester of PE every year. If choosing an elective other than PE, a PE waiver is required to be completed by the parent on the back of this form. Completing a PE waiver does not guarantee that your student will not have PE.

Classes are offered based on the choices you make. The choices you make are binding. If you do not choose elective courses and your first-choice electives are full, your classes will be chosen for you and schedule change requests will not be honored. Schedule changes will not be made because you decide that you do not want to take a course any longer. Please choose wisely as you will be taking the classes you select.
