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Getting Ready for Third Grade

- Grammar-identify nouns, verbs, and adjectives
- Writing- practice writing paragraphs with a topic sentence and supporting details, including proper punctuation and capitalization.
- Math– Make sure to have the addition and subtraction facts mastered and memorized fluently within 1-20. Use flash cards or apps to practice.
- Math—Begin understanding and memorizing multiplication facts 0—9.
