

Bell Schedule

- One hour early dismissal on Wednesdays (shorter classes).
- Suggested drop off time:
 - 7:00-7:25
 - Doors open at 7:10 am






Buses unload at 7:10 am. Students enter through the back loop and can go straight to class or to breakfast. At the end of the day, the 1st bell signals the bus rider dismissal.




Drop off is in the front of the building, excluding the front loop. Students are allowed in the building at 7:10, outside supervision begins at 7:00. Students are dismissed by section to the parent drop off line.











Course Progression – Math/Science




