



8th Grade Core Class Placement


- Placement is based on student dataoverall class grade, summative scores, latest Milestone, Beacon score.

- no high school credit






8th Grade Core Class Placement

Language Arts/Reading-

- two classes in one period
- two levels of instruction: on level and advance
- grammar, writing, and reading skills
- no high school credit
- high school pathways





8th Grade Core Class Placement SPANISH I

- ☐ Takes place of reading class
- One level of instruction: on level only
- ☐ Skills include: listening, speaking, and writing
- High school credit shown on high school transcript
- No Milestone test
- Popular HS World Language Pathways
 - ☐ Spanish I, II, III, IV, AP
 - ☐ Latin I, II, III, IV, AP




8th Grade Core Class Placement Physical Science

- ☐ Lots of math: chemistry and physics
- Placement based on 7th grade math grades, not 7th grade science grades.
- Two levels of instruction
 - On Level (on-level math)
 - Advance/Gifted (advance/accelerated math)
- ☐ High school credit on high school transcript
- ☐ Milestone (EOG/EOC) -score does not impact report card grade at this time. This could change next year.


8th Grade Core Class Placement Math

- □ 8th Grade On Level (Pre-Algebra)
 - Not a high school credit
 - Preparation for 9th Algebra I
 - Milestone EOG- does not impact report card grade
- □ Algebra 1
 - Most 7th advance math students
 - High school credit on high school transcript
 - 1st sem= 40% of overall grade
 - 2nd sem= 40% of overall grade
 - Milestone test (EOC)= 20% of overall report card grade

8th Grade Core Class Placement Math

- 8th Accelerated Math
 - Current 7th accelerated students
 - Full year of Algebra I and first semester of Geometry in a single year.
 - High school credit on high school transcript
 - 1st sem= 40% of overall grade
 - 2nd sem= 40% of overall grade
 - Milestone test (EOC)= 20% of overall report card grade
 - Same Milestone EOC as Algebra 1.

Math Pathways

- · Students must earn 4 units of Math to graduate.
- Foundations of Algebra is a first year high school mathematics course option for students who have completed
 mathematics in grades 6 8 yet will need substantial support to bolster success in high school mathematics

High School Credit Classes

- High school courses and grades do show on high school transcript.
- High school credits earned in middle school <u>do not</u> calculate into a student's high school GPA or class rank.
- Some colleges may choose to recalculate a student's GPA for admission purposes.
