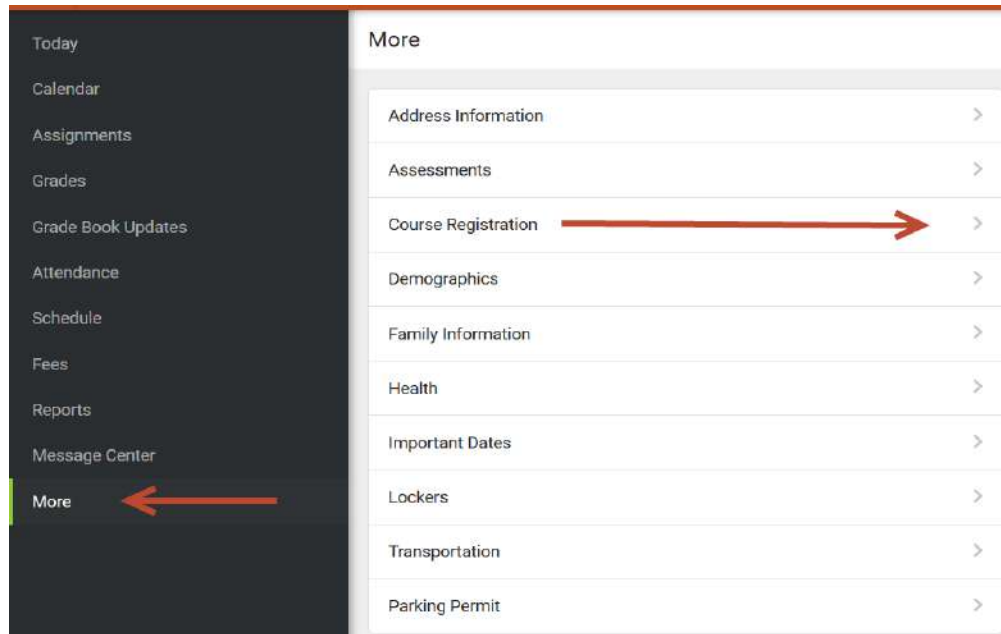
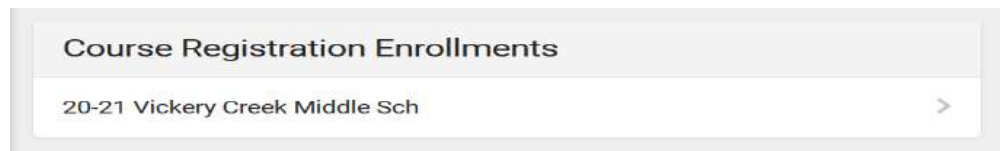


Course view instructions for Parent Portal

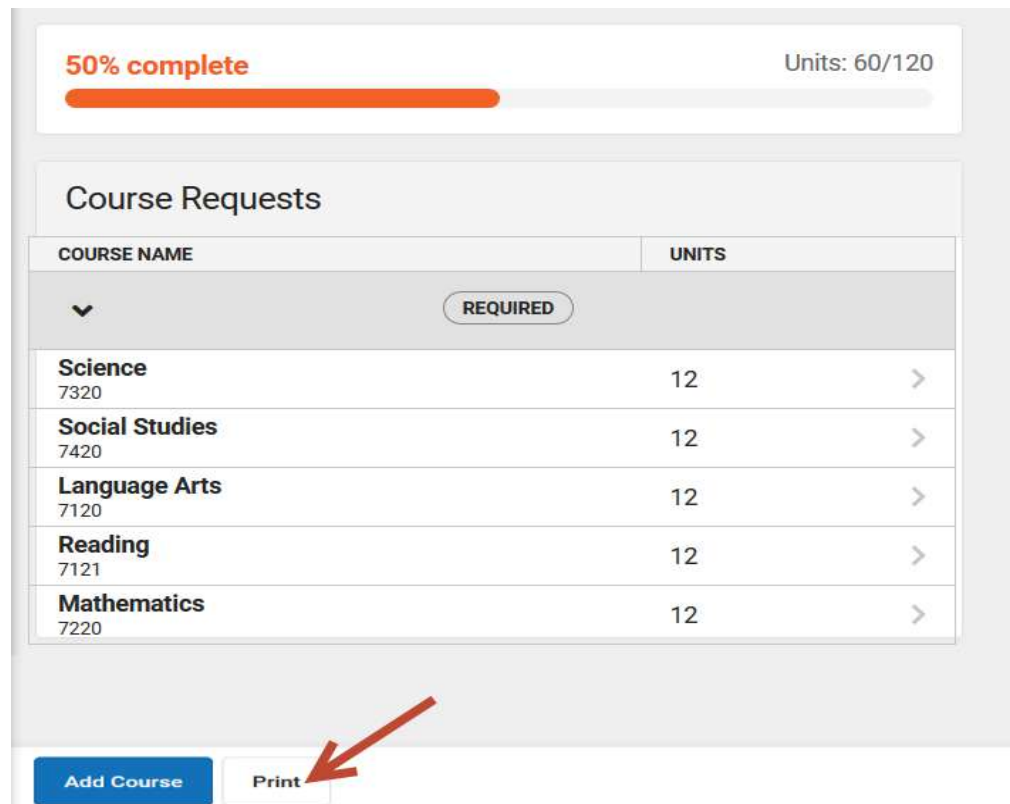
Please log into your parent portal account. If you do not have a parent portal account, please contact the front office of your current school. On the left-hand side of your screen at the bottom, select “More”. Then select “Course Registration.”

The next screen to appear will show the 5 core academic courses for your student. This is a view of the core courses only. Connection courses are school selected over the summer, unless student signs-up for band and/or chorus.



At the bottom, you will select print. Please keep this documentation for future reference.

Points of Emphasis

- What does each course number mean for the 8th grade middle school courses?
 - The first digit should be an 8 for 8th grade.
 - The second digit is the content number.
 - 1= ELA and Reading
 - 2= Math
 - 3= Science
 - 4= Social Studies
 - The last 2 digits represent the level of instruction.
 - Courses ending in a 20 or 30 are advance level.
 - All other courses are on-level (01, 07, 10, or 11).
- How do I know if the placement is a high school course for high school credit?
 - Spanish I is a high school course for high school credit. There is only one level of instruction for this course. The course number is 50705ms.
 - Physical Science is a high school course for high school credit. There is an on-level course with course number 30305ms. There is an advance level course with course numbers 33305ms and 32305ms.
 - GSE Algebra I is an advanced math course for high school credit. Its course numbers are 20455ms and 22455ms.
 - Accelerated math involves all of Algebra I and the 1st semester of high school geometry. The official name of the course is GSE ACC Alg 1/Geo A honors. The course numbers include 20485ms and 22485ms.
 - There are no high school courses for high school credit offered at the middle school level for Language Arts or Social Studies.
- Placements were determined by your child's progress and work habits in each content area. Progress refers to overall 1st semester grade, current 2nd semester grade, overall grade for the year, 1st semester summative grades, and 2nd semester summative grades. Work habits include: how fast and accurate your child master's new skills, amount of participation and engagement, level of questioning and dialogue, etc.
- Teachers no longer have access to see your child's placements and do not have access to make placement changes.
- After Wednesday, May 12, you will no longer have access to view these course placements. Make sure you print a copy or take a picture of the course placements for future reference.
- Students schedules will be distributed at Viper Camp in late July.
