Course Overview – 7th Grade Mathematics provides a bridge between elementary arithmetic and algebra. It aligns with the GA Standards of Excellence and brings some high school algebra and geometry to the middle school.

1st Nine Weeks – Number Systems and Expressions & Equations (Units 1 & 2)
2nd Nine Weeks – Expressions and Equations/Ratios and Proportions (Units 2 & 3)
3rd Nine Weeks – Geometry & Inferences (Units 4 & 5)
4th Nine Weeks – Inferences & Probability (Units 5 & 6)
