



Delaware System of Student Assessments (DeSSA) Exemption Policy 2022-2023

What are Exemptions for DeSSA Assessments?

- Provide the district or charter with an opportunity to request a student not be included for state assessment testing and therefore, not be included in the participation rate.
- Allow students to be excluded from specific assessments and content areas.

What is a valid exemption?

- Any student who is enrolled in a private or in-state treatment facility that cannot provide testing.
- Any student who is enrolled in an out-of-state facility.
- Any student who is incarcerated in an adult prison.
- Any student with a medical exemption unable to test before the end of the window.
- Any student who has a logistical or technical reason and was unable to test. Examples:
 Student is at an alternate location without trained test administrators; vendor-related issue keeps the student from testing before the end of the testing window.
- Any student enrolled in the last two calendar weeks of the test window.
- Homebound Alt students because paper/pencil is not available.

When and how are exemptions submitted?

- All forms are available in LEA-specific folders in Schoology
- Passwords for the Schoology folders will be distributed to DTCs via KACE
- Use the DOE approved exemption forms to submit exemptions
- Submit all exemptions by identified due dates
- DTCs are responsible for completing the exemption forms
- Medical exemptions must include an assurance by the DTC that documentation is on file

What reasons are exemptions not approved?

- Missing an identified reason
- Absence/Truancy
- Medical condition without an assurance of medical documentation
- Student is registered for the wrong assessment
- First-year MLL exempt request for other content areas than ELA (e.g.., math, essay, science, and social studies)
- Parent opt-out
- Incorrect information provided
- Student is enrolled in a virtual academy
