- 4. A faculty selection committee will review the applications and recommendations for final selections. Selection letters will be delivered the week of November 14
- **5.** Students selected for membership will be invited, with their families, to attend the Induction Ceremony to be held SPRING

- f. Give out three teacher recommendation forms for your teachers to complete: It is your responsibility to put your name on the forms. You can only use 1 recommendation from a previous year's teacher. The teachers you have asked form recommendations will turn the forms in, confidentially to Mrs. Arnold.
