Guidelines

1. The yearbook should:

 - c. include students, staff, and activities.
2. The theme, including layouts, headlines, captions and body copy, all arts and pictures, should represent the highest of photographic, artistic and literary quality.
3. The production of a school yearbook should be regarded as an honored opportunity, and should result in a cherished remembrance of school days within the District's secondary schools.
