E. W. Oliver Elementary School administrators and teachers review of student performance data reveals the following. All “intensive” readers will work towards achieving a level of benchmark as indicated by the Reading and Math DIBELS on the EOY (end of year) Diebls/mClass. Each assessment tool provides meaningful data to reveal target areas for improvement.

2016- 2017 goal is to increase by 5% on the GMAS
By the end of school year 2017- 2018 increase will be by 10% on the GMAS

The objective of our school goals are to prepare each student for common core curriculum readiness.

2nd Grade SMART Goals

- ◆ Advance reading and math fluency with 90% accuracy
- ◆ Express thoughts in writing using sight words, word family words, and vocabulary words
- ◆ Solve multi-step mathematical problems using varied strategies and critical thinking skills

In-The Classroom

Strategies implemented and provided by teachers are:

- ◇ Increase reading fluency by reading an AR 30 minutes daily with an adult as part of homework nightly and documented on daily reading log
- ◇ Increase sight word recognition by using flashcards, written format and repetition
- ◇ Exposure to weekly vocabulary words identified by curriculum and demonstrated with flash cards
- ◇ Increase critical thinking with multi-step word problems during math instruction and for nightly homework assign-

Student Will

- ◇ Practice reading 30 minutes or more with parents of assigned reading and document on daily reading log
- ◇ Practice learning sight words with repetition with my parents
- ◇ Practice learning vocabulary words with repetition with parents using different activities to increase vocabulary
- ◇ Demonstrate multi-step word mathematical problems

Parents Will

- ◇ Practice reading with my child for 30 minutes or more daily and document on daily reading log with signature
- ◇ Help my child to learn sight words with repetition daily from homework packets
- ◇ Help my child increase vocabulary by completing the vocabulary activities from homework packets
- ◇ Practice with my child multi-step word mathematical problem

- ◆ Provide frequent reports to parents on their children’s progress
