Second grade is currently focused on the following concepts: <u>Math</u> - We will continue our study into the next unit. In Unit 3, students will explore measuring length, in terms of inches, feet, and yards. We will also learn how to create line plots using our measurements. Finally, we will learn how to tell time within 5 minutes on an analog clock.

**Language Arts** - We will continue to study and use key features to locate information and facts in informational texts. Also using informational texts, students will identify the main idea and author's purpose in a multi-paragraph texts. Furthermore, students will describe how reasons support specific points in a text.

**<u>Writing</u>** - Students will continue our informational writing unit where we will learn to write informational texts about a topic. Students will choose a topic and use mentor texts to learn to write an informational piece that includes important text features.

<u>Social Studies</u> - We will begin our Economics unit where we will learn about scarcity, opportunity costs, goods, services, and saving and spending choices.

**Science** - We will further study and explore motion, forces, and gravity. Students will apply what they've learned from the investigations in order to design a roller coaster.
