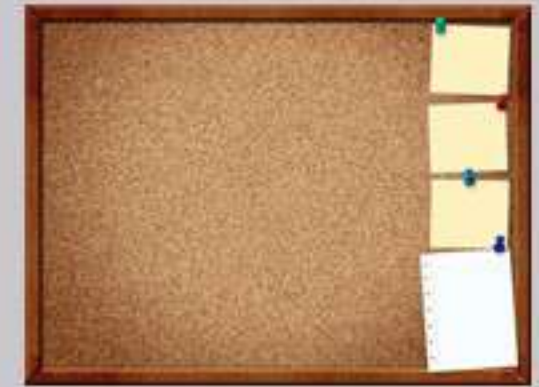

Prepare for Success

Wake up when directed.

- Eyes watching, ears listening, bodies calm.
- Be on time – join the meeting a few minutes before time.
- Be an active participant.

- Have all supplies needed.
- Check for assignments every day & start working as soon as you get an assignment.



Act Respectfully

Listen to & follow all your caregivers instructions

- Mouths quiet & no food!
- Dress appropriately,
- Raise your hand and wait to be called on.
- Only use the chat box when appropriate & only use positive words!

- If you cannot complete an assignment, let the teacher know.



Work Together

Get along with family members.

- No distractions & get to a quiet area.
- Your computer should be muted unless you have been asked to respond verbally.
- Your camera should be off unless you have been asked to share.

- Complete your assignments independently.
- Ask for help when you need it.



Stay Safe

Wash your hands frequently.

- Only use approved websites. If you are not sure if it's an appropriate site, ask your teacher or caregiver.

- Take a break from technology throughout the day.
