Likewise all assignments should be submitted into Google Classroom. Please ensure that upon submission the document that your child was working on is saved and then attach it in the classroom. This is to ensure that the submit icon is not being hit, without the completed assignment.

There is a red flag for missing assignments or when the assignment is returned to the student. Please make every effort to monitor your child's Google Classroom to be aware of what is happening.
