Reading: We will be reading daily to build stamina. Our reading skills focus this month will be on: main idea, inferencing, understanding text features, and summarizing informational texts.

Writing: We will be building the writing community and learning about being authors. Third grade will also be working on writing and identifying complete and incomplete sentences. We will be looking at the different types of nouns (common, proper) that we

Math: The math skills taught this month are rounding to the nearest 10 or 100, multiplying one digit by multiples of 10, solving real word problems with perimeter, adding and subtracting within 1000, and multiplying and dividing within 100

REMEMBER to practice multiplication facts daily (0s, 1s and 10s)

Science: As scientists, third graders will be learning about how each plant and animal has different structures that serve specific functions on growth, survival and reproduction.

Social Studies: We will learn how to read maps and to use them to identify the seven continents and their locations on Earth.
