Book Cover

Create a book cover for the book you read. Make sure it looks different from the actual book cover. On the front include the title, author, illustrator, and picture. On the back include setting, characters, author's intent (purpose), genre, and a summary of the book.

Material(s): drawing paper, markers, crayons, colored pencils

Comic Strip

Create a comic strip showing 5 major events from the book in sequence. Include captions and/or dialogue bubbles to retell the story along with pictures.

Material(s): Comic Strip activity sheet, markers, crayons, colored pencils

Friendly Letter

Write a one page letter to a friend recommending your book. Tell your friend what the book was about and why you would recommend it. Make sure you include the title, author, characters, and setting.

Write a letter to one of the characters in the story. Talk to them about events that happened in the story. You can also ask them questions about the events that happened.

Poem or Song

Create a poem or song that summarizes the story. Include the title, author, illustrator, setting, characters, author's intent (purpose), and summary.

Book Report Cube

Complete the sides of the book report cube. You will include title, author, illustrator, setting, characters, beginning, middle, end, connection (text to self, text to text, text to world), and author's intent (purpose).

Grammar Search

Poster Board Advertisement
