Self-Selected Reading Project: One-Pager Due: March 8, 2016

After reading your independent reading book this nine weeks, you are going to create a "one-pager" in which you draw/represent major ideas from the novel. The One-Pager should include the following:

- > the title of the novel
- ➤ a short summary of the novel (4~5 sentences)
- > three important quotes from the novel
- > a personal response to the novel (at least three sentences)
 You may want to include here what you learned from reading the novel.
- ➤ at least **three** pictures of major people/things/events from the novel
- > at least **three** symbols from the novel and what they represent
- ➤ at least **two** other items/pictures that represent literary elements from the novel (foreshadowing/symbolism/irony/figurative language, etc.)
- ➤ One the <u>back</u> of the one-pager, you are to write 1-2 paragraphs in which you discuss the theme of the book. Include at least <u>three</u> pieces of evidence from the book in your respone.

You can use markers, colored pencils, and any other items to make your one-pager stand out from the crowd. You can also create a computer-generated one pager if you so desire. Be creative and do your best.
