Athletic Clearance: With well over 500 student athletes, we are just not able to reply to emails or phone calls to confirm that your student's clearance has uploaded. Please trust the system unless you hear from us otherwise. If you have issues with uploading your documents or need a blank copy of the EL2 form, please reach out to wendy.lay@stjohns.k12.fl.us.

Anyone with May participation or tryouts will need to be sure that the physical on file for 2021-22 is current. If it has expired, please upload a current one. This should be Football, Dance and Cheer.

All athletes should log in and add 2022-23 and upload the current EL2 to their clearance account. *Please do not wait* until school is out to add 2022-23. This will help to avoid delays or disruption in participation when their camps and/or season comes around. Your student's Coach, our Trainer, or Mrs. Lay will reach out if anything is needed. If their EL2/physical expires before or during season, they will need to go back in and update that as soon as they have the new one in hand.

Students who had physicals done at Spartan Orthopedic on April 23 were advised to take a photo and use that to upload the EL2 into their student clearance account.

Guidance News

<u>AP Students:</u> You can send **one score report for free** every year that you take AP Exams. The deadline for choosing the college, university, or scholarship program that you want to send your 2022 AP scores to for free is **June 20**. Here's how:

- Sign in to My AP using your College Board username and password.
- Go to My AP Profile and select the Score Send tab.
- Type in the name of your college or university. When it appears on the list, select it and hit Save.

Good to Know

- Are you a high school junior, sophomore, or freshman? Selecting a college to send your scores to with your 1 free score send can help you stand out to that college by showing them your interest early.
- Score reports include both this year's and past AP Exam scores.

If you miss the deadline to use your 2022 free score send or you want to send additional score reports, you can order score reports online or by mail or fax anytime.

Junior Update:

School counselors will be visiting Juniors in their US History classes during the month of May! We will be completing a "super match" activity that will help students find their "best fit" schools to apply to for college. We will also be talking about how to start and finish the college application process. If you haven't already, now would be a great time to speak with your student about your family plans for location, type of school, areas of interest, etc. Once these visits are completed, the information will be shared via Schoology and the webpage.

SAT Update:

Registration for our last SAT of the spring, on June 4, is open for one more month. Juniors who haven't taken it yet should <u>register</u> today.

Students who've already taken the SAT should link their College Board accounts to Khan Academy® so they'll be well prepared to take it again in the summer or fall

<u>Bright Futures</u> – New rules regarding <u>Bright Futures Scholarship Service Forms/Rules</u> are posted on the District Web Site and will be available in the TCHS Guidance Services office.

Registration Update:

The counselors have finished meeting with all the students to select their courses. From this point forward, all schedule change requests should be requested through the link on our website: https://www-tchs.stjohns.k12.fl.us/registration/courses/. The deadline to request elective changes is June 2nd.

SAT Update:


