








### **Community Schools Connections**







#### Families & Students



Families & Students are not just recipients of service, they are key partners, contributors and problem solvers at the school. With their lived experience and wisdom, families and students inform strategies and programs that lead to transformational change.





#### **Community School Coordinators (CSC)**



Community School Coordinators (CSC) are the bridge between families, schools, and communities. They help schools integrate and align services and resources to achieve the school's goals and vision.





### Community Partners (CP)



Community Partners (CP) include afterschool providers, healthcare organizations, local businesses, faith-based organizations, social service providers, local community members, and others who provide services and resources to meet family and student needs.





#### **Community School Hui**



Community School Hui, is a leadership team of school administrators, teachers, CPs, students, families, and the CSC. Together they plan and implement the Community School strategy and create innovative solutions that leads to better student and family outcomes.

#### **Community School Coordinator Roles**

The Community School Coordinator focuses on engaging, inspiring, and aligning Community School partners towards a common vision, addressing shared challenges utilizing assets of the local community.

- Responsible for the implementation, integration, alignment and coordination of the community school strategy
- Convenes a Community School Hui
- Builds a schoolwide system of supports to connect community partners and resources to faculty, students and families
- Integrates and aligns efforts with PCNC and other family engagement specialists or initiatives to work collaboratively to achieve the school's vision and break down silos





# **How Many Community Schools?**







#### ~10,000 Community Schools!

- Roughly 10,000 community schools operate in the U.S., representing between 6% to 8% of all public schools. But that may soon change. <u>US</u> <u>News & Report</u>
